

The amazingly versatile 2100 is up to the challenge of a weekend race. But it won't let you down when you've planned a few days of lazy cruising or gunkholing. It's got enough ocean racer in it to stretch your skills. And some easy-to-take little luxuries you'll appreciate when you're out enjoying the sun with family and friends.

Features you'll love, rather than just learn to live with.

Comfort on a boat is a lot more than a few overstuffed cushions.

In the design of 2100, we took the **whole sailing experience** into account. Take ease of handling, for instance. The $\frac{1}{2}$ rig of the 2100 requires less muscle and a smaller inventory of needed sails for cruising and racing.

You'll notice an unusually generous amount of usable deck space. The high freeboard makes for dry comfortable sailing even in windy conditions. The cockpit is roomy and comfortable, with seating for six adults and high seat backs for long-range comfort.

Other features include a bridge deck to stop water on its way



below. A gas tank storage locker that keeps fumes out of the cabin. And split backstay to give the helmsman all the elbow room he needs.


You're in control.

The 2100 is easy to handle and remarkably responsive.

All lines needed to control the boat lead back to a console at the companionway where the winches are situated.

Jib sheets can be led to either the windward or leeward winch for ease of sail trim.

And the other controls – all of them standard – include vang, Cunningham and internal halyards. All with stoppers for fast, precise and simple control.



Above-average comfort below decks.

The 2100 sleeps four in surprising comfort and room – a far cry from the usual day sailing



accommodations. You'll like the four full-size berths, separate head compartment and well-thought-out galley space.

Full sitting headroom and ports at eye level provide a feeling of spaciousness and a standard cowl vent keeps things airy and cool.

Let's talk about value.

Value is important, so you'll want to take a close look at the way the 2100 is put together.

You'll find a gleaming smooth hull from molds that are hand buffed to assure a flawless finish. Waterline colors are molded in to stay bright.

Barent winches, Harken fittings, Schaefer blocks, Kenyon spars – your 2100 comes equipped with quality hardware that works better and withstands punishment longer. Sails crafted in the one-design loft of Hood Sails of Marblehead, Mass. are available.

And the bow pulpit, navigational lights, lifelines, and a spring loaded outboard mounting bracket are all standard.

Wherever you look, you'll find an impressive attention to detail, craftsmanship and the kind of quality that makes your 2100 an ideal boating investment.


