



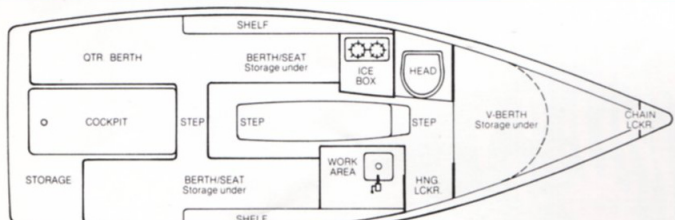

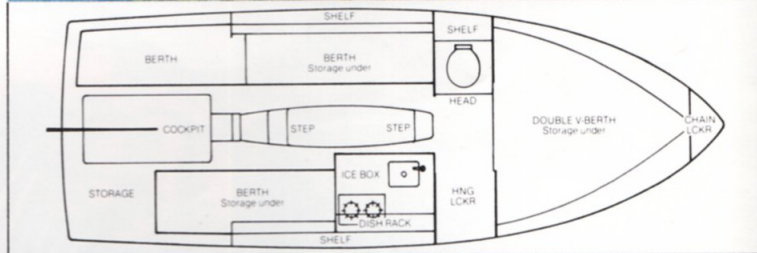

Impossible dream?

American Mariner Industries has dramatically reduced the number of compromises cruising enthusiasts have always had to weigh. It is no longer necessary to choose between rail-down tenderness and a

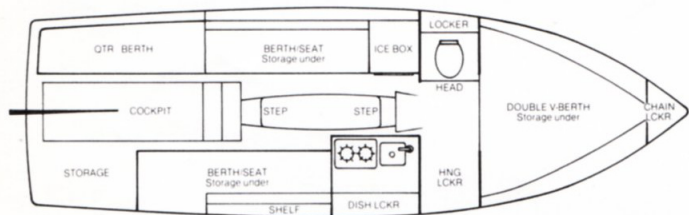
bothersome centerboard swinging below. No longer must you ruefully accept cramped quarters and head-banging sitting-headroom as part of the "fun" of sailing.

Here is a selection . . .

cruising yachts which are revolutionary in many meaningful ways yet not the least bit bizarre. The Americans have a comfortable, reassuring, sturdy appearance and behavior with responsive "stand up" sailing in weather that with many another sailboat might give cause for apprehension.

Hull conformations permit maximum stability and interior roominess. The original, patented (Patent Nos. 394819 and 239375) stabilizer keel, recessed inside, provides stand-up covered headroom without recourse to a pop-up-top or excessive freeboard. In addition to solving the headroom problem, the keel allows the boats to ride low on a trailer, retain shallow draft characteristics and eliminate the usual centerboard with its problems and awkward trunk in the cabin. Molded as an integral part of the hulls, lead is bonded into the keel providing

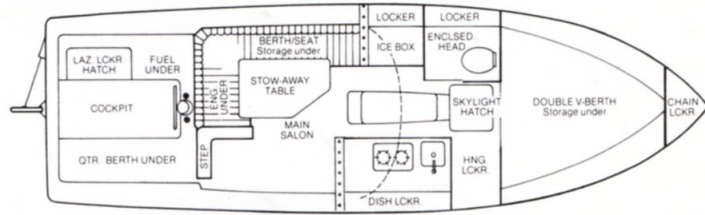

"Rudder struggle" is eliminated in launching the Americans. No straining to set the rudder in place after launching. Simply set the rudder before launching or just leave it in position—even for trailering.

The American's hull design permits exceptional under-power performance while utilizing the most economical of auxiliary engines (6 to 10 h.p. outboard is adequate). Inboard auxiliary power is optional for the 22, 24 and 26 cruising sloops with safe, dependable and economical inboard diesel power featured as standard equipment in the 28 Motorsailer.

The very design characteristics which make the Americans so stable and sea-easy work absolute wonders to interior spaciousness.

One-piece molded fiberglass hull and cabin inner liners all but eliminate interior maintenance and condensation. Generous use of oiled teak bulkheads, cabinetry and trim blend with color-coordinated fabric cushions and carpeting to create a rich feeling of warmth and comfort. A multitude of practical design features make your cruising more enjoyable. Uncramped fully equipped galleys, each with stand-up headroom. Tables convenient to the galley, but completely stow-away when not in use. Large eye-level windows and rigid skylight forward hatches. Separate head compartments, hanging lockers, king size berths and maximum utilization of space for storage.

The Americans are built for rugged cruising. Sturdy construction techniques include hand-laid fiberglass hulls and plywood reinforced sandwich lamination in all cabin tops, decks, cockpits and transoms.
