


AQUARIUS 21



Whether you're exploring a secluded lagoon or camping "aboard" in the privacy of the forest, the Aquarius 21 is the perfect choice.

Racing or cruising, you'll enjoy the balance of the helm and the flexibility of adjusting the centerboard depth. You will be pleased with the way the Aquarius 21 stands up to a heavy blow. When the bay becomes a twilight millpond and the breeze is barely perceptible, she'll ghost along with ease.

Maintenance is never a problem with Aquarius. The rugged construction and quality hardware are unsurpassed.

The large convenient interior has quickly become an Aquarius trademark. Berths sleep four adults or a family of five with ample stowage underneath. The head area is always accessible.

Consider the draft of only 12 inches with centerboard up and you'll know the secret to easy launching anywhere you can pull the boat. She floats off the trailer with hardly any effort at all.



STANDARD EQUIPMENT: Pop-up hatch covers with hasp. Choice of non-skid, shear stripe and waterline color. Self-bailing cockpit. Outboard rudder with laminated tiller. Internal ballast with metal centerboard. Centerboard winch. **INTERIOR** – Five berths with Fiberglass interior liner. Countertop with drawer and cabinet door. Head compartment. **HARDWARE** – Stand-up blocks with anodized cheeks and delrin sheaves. Cam cleats for main and jib. Jib fairleads on cars. Hinged mast step. Bow eye. Bow and stern cleats. **RIGGING** – Stainless rigging with swage fittings and stainless adjustable turnbuckles. Stainless halyards with dacron tails. Dacron sheets. Anodized aluminum spars. Roller reefing gooseneck.
