The Aquarius 21 is the sailboat that makes fun a family affair! It is safe, roomy, easy to trailer and smooth to sail. And your new Aquarius 21 is loaded with features you wouldn't expect to find on any other sailboat her size.

With more leisure time available for family recreation, explore the mobility and family involvement available with trailerable sailboat cruising. Peter Barrett, well-known naval architect, designed the Aquarius 21 for the comfort and convenience of first-time sailing and cruising families. Check the features below and you'll agree that the Aquarius 21 makes fun a family affair.

SAFETY FEATURES

For safety performance, the Aquarius 21 is hard to beat. She is completely self-righting even with the centerboard up. The unique skiff keel and centerboard provide a total of 665 lbs. built-in ballast, assuring you and your family of excellent stability. The high freeboard and self-bailing cockpit have been designed for dry sailing in all sea conditions. You can trust your family to the Aquarius 21.

MOBILITY

Your Aquarius 21 is designed for convenience and mobility. Her retractable centerboard and removable spade rudder provide a draft of only 12 inches, allowing you to beach the boat, or to explore secluded coves, inlets and rivers inaccessible to other boats. She sits low on the trailer so you can use her as a camper while "aground" at your campsite. Enjoy the mobility of an Aquarius 21 and make fun your family's affair.

UNDERWAY IN 30 MINUTES

The Aquarius 21 has been designed for easy trailering and launching. She is easily rigged, launched and underway in less than 30 minutes. The Aquarius Owner's Guide, distributed with every new boat, provides a detailed how-to-do-it approach. By following these three easy steps, you can be underway while most other boats are still at the ramp:



1. Upon arrival at the launch ramp, back the trailer into the water, apply brakes and your Aquarius 21 will float gently off the trailer. 6 minutes.



SPACIOUS INTERIOR

The large, convenient interior has quickly become an Aquarius trademark. The "pop-top" design offers you standing headroom (5'9") in the activity portion of the cabin, including the galley. She sleeps four six-footers, has a built in head area accessible without converting a berth, and contains many storage compartments. The interior is further highlighted by hand-rubbed mahogany trim.



EXTERIOR FEATURES

The quality construction of the Aquarius 21 is unsurpassed, with each boat built of extra heavy mat, cloth and woven roving laminations, by hand, insuring increased strength. The sailing hardware, stainless steel and anodized aluminum fittings surpass the quality of other boats in her class. Each Aquarius is backed by a one year warranty and full customer service program. 2. Raise the mast, set the boom and check all rigging (this may be done prior to launching if you prefer). 13 minutes.



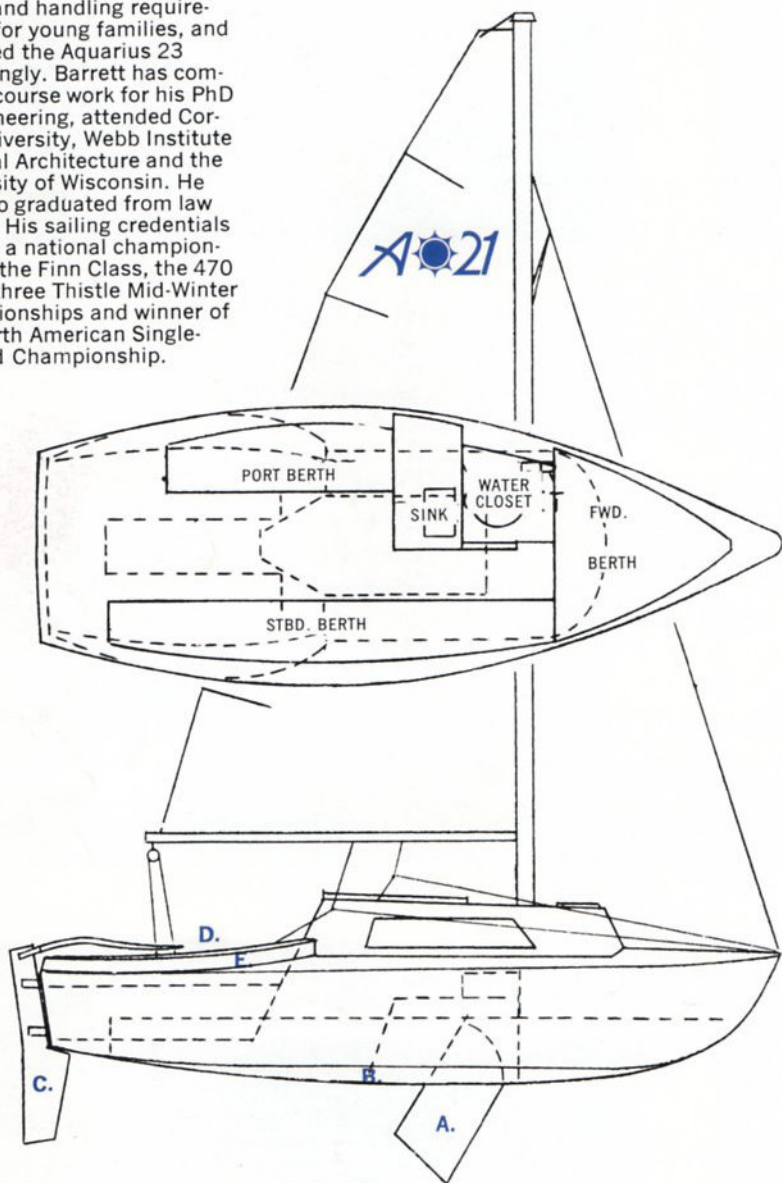
3. Rig the sails, set the rudder and centerboard, and you're off for an exciting family sail. 9 minutes.

The roomy interior has made the Aquarius one of the most popular new trailerable cruising sailboat designs available. She sleeps four, has an efficient galley and dinette, loads of locker space, a separate head area, and a choice of three tastefully designed interior motifs.

For safety and performance, check the following features on the diagram:

- A.** A true centerboard that retracts completely so you can beach the boat and do some exploring.
- B.** A skiff keel with ballast assures excellent stability and makes the Aquarius self-righting even with the centerboard fully retracted.
- C.** A removeable or optional kick-up rudder for increased responsiveness and easier handling.
- D.** A large cockpit with comfortable backrests and lots of room for six adults.
- E.** Extra freeboard provides an additional margin of safety and keeps the cockpit dry in foul weather.
