TRAIL AND SAIL THE BALBOA 20

The Balboa is a trailerable sailboat for lakes, rivers or ocean sailing and will easily tow behind even a small family car. The heavy 450 lb. retractable keel makes her self-righting and most stable.

She has an extra thick, hand-laid fiberglass hull using woven roving. There is plenty of room in the self-bailing cockpit . . . and the winch for the positive-locking keel is within easy reach of the helmsman. When it comes to comfort, there is no other cabin like the Balboa 20 with a large four-bunk cabin and room for head and galley. A standard dinette provides more than ample sit-up room for the tallest.

The beginning sailor will enjoy learning to sail the Balboa 20 as will the experienced sailor. A racing enthusiast will be thrilled by her speed and quickness and response. She is listed in M.O.R.A. in rugged San Francisco Bay at 20.5 and is raced under handicap in some areas. In others, classes are being formed.

An outboard bracket is available which is stressed for a 10 horsepower motor although 5 horsepower is sufficient.






