

# BALBOA 26



The Balboa 26 is the cornerstone of the colorful and traditional Balboa line.

The 26 has proven herself race worthy in all levels of competition throughout the boating world. Yet, she maintains the style and thoughtful design to make her immensely popular with those who find cruising their boating pleasure.

Her 1200 pounds of keel ballast combine with the sleek hull design for an exceptionally "stiff" performance. The mainsheet traveler mounted above the sliding cabin hatch facilitates a finely tuned sail trim and frees the cockpit for crew maneuvering or relaxing under a warm sun.

A fiberglass liner, deep shag carpet, color coordinated cushions and window curtains make the roomy cabin an inviting atmosphere for cruising vacations.

The Balboa 26 combines the traditional line of a fine yacht with the convenience of trailability to provide a classic value for the sailing enthusiast.



**STANDARD EQUIPMENT:** Removable inboard spade rudder with laminated tiller. Self-bailing cockpit. Choice of non-skid, shear stripe and water line color. Two large lazarette hatches. Forward hatch with hatch holder and latch. Main sliding hatch with hasp. **INTERIOR** – Interior hull liner. Berths for five. Enclosed head and hanging locker. Teak bulkheads and trim. Top loading ice box, sink and countertops with cabinet doors. **HARDWARE** – Mid boom main sheet traveler. Motor mount. Hinged mast step. Boweye, deck hardware including fairleads, blocks and mooring cleats. **RIGGING** – Rotary swaged stainless steel standing rigging with adjustable turnbuckles. Spreaders, double lower shrouds and split backstay. Braided dacron and stainless steel running rigging. Anodized aluminum spars.
