


# BALBOA 8.2



The newest design from the drawing board of Lyle Hess is the Balboa 8.2. The 8.2, the largest of the traditionally excellent Balboa line, is designed with the classical features synonymous with performance and style.

The shallow draft keel carries 2100 pounds of ballast and the retractable centerboard adds 200 pounds for a total ballast of 2300 pounds. The centerboard assures excellent windward performance and good maneuverability while it can be retracted off the wind to reduce drag and provide access to shallow coves.

The six-foot, two-inch headroom opens up the main salon for spacious accommodations including facing settees. The large, airy galley lends itself to comfortable, effortless meal preparation. Other interior features include: enclosed head, berths for six, hanging locker, plenty of storage for extended cruising and teak bulkheads and trim.

When you couple the race-proven hull design with an extremely livable interior you'll understand why the Balboa 8.2 commands respect from competitors and cruising veterans alike.



**STANDARD EQUIPMENT:** Outboard retractable rudder with laminated tiller. Internal ballast and metal centerboard adjustable from the cockpit. Self-bailing cockpit. Winch mounting pads. Anchor locker. Choice of non-skid, shear stripe and water line color. **INTERIOR** — Six berths. Countertop with cabinet doors. Teak bulkheads and trim. Enclosed head and compartment. **HARDWARE** — Main sheet traveler or bridge deck with blocks and cam cleat on car. Jib fairleads. Hinged mast step. Bow eye. Bow and stern cleats. **RIGGING** — Heavy-duty stainless rigging with swage fittings and stainless adjustable turnbuckles. Stainless halyards with dacron tails. Dacron sheets. Anodized aluminum spars.
