

Sail Plan

**STANDARD BOAT — \$41,500** (includes the following as standard equipment as of August 1, 1979).

**FIBERGLASS CONSTRUCTION** — hand laid-up alternate layers of fiberglass mat and woven roving hull and deck head-liner, hull liner and deck also cored with  $\frac{3}{8}$ " balsa, anchor locker, sliding companionway, spray hood and cockpit hatches cored with plywood. Smoke white only standard colour, 4 colour choice for boot and cove stripe.

**ENGINE and ELECTRICAL** — 15 h.p. Yanmar diesel with 2:1 reduction turning three bladed, bronze propeller; ignition panel; waterlift muffler system.

— 12 volt battery and electrical panel with separate fuses and switches, interior lights include one red-white combination light in navigation area, one over galley, two in salon, one in the head, two in forward cabin; navigation lights include fore-deck bow light combination on mast, port and starboard forward lights; stern light; red night light in compass; 12-volt exhaust blower for

engine compartment; fire extinguisher; 20-gallon aluminum fuel tank in keel giving an auxiliary cruising range of about 450-500 miles.

**INTERIOR APPOINTMENTS and EQUIPMENT** — extensive use of natural teak and teak veneers in the interior; all bulkheads, chainplate knees, cockpit and main cabin shelves glassed to hull for additional strength; chain locker in foc'sl; storage under all berths and seats; 4" fabric-covered high density foam berth and seat cushions throughout; curtains and deep pile carpeting.

— forward cabin with shelves port and starboard; V-berth with filler, 7'6" starboard, 7'0" port; hanging locker to port, shelf over; head to starboard with dorade vent and opening port, shelves hide-away vanity with sink and pump; head with 16-gallon holding tank, teak floor grate, mirror, handrails fore and aft; door closes off head or forward cabin.

— main salon U-shaped dinette to starboard with two fill-in cushions to form extra double berth (if required); fixed centre table tray with hinged table sides; quilted upholstery backrests on settee and dinette with storage outboard; shelf lockers over sliding panels - port and starboard; overhead and bulkhead teak handrails; liquor locker with glass rack over settee.

— galley U-shaped with stainless steel sink; 12-volt pressure freshwater pump connect to 20-gallon tank; four cubic foot icebox with teak ice grate and drain - to pump at sink; dish locker; gimballed two-burner alcohol stove with oven - stowing cover over stove for extra counter space, when required; two gallon remote alcohol tank; two drawers and lockers; dorade vent over stove; teak handholds in galley and on companionway trim.

— convertible navigation area to port with storage inside; shelf and locker; 12-volt electrical panel; chart table lifts and slides stowing flush in port ceiling panel; backrest cushion removes and fills in foot space to form 6'9" quarterberth (if required); companionway stairs easily removed for access to all maintenance areas on engine.

— overhead companionway screen, self-stowing into spray hood; removable screen for forward hatch.

**DECK HARDWARE** — stainless steel chainplates and weldments; stainless steel bow and stern pulpit; lifeline assembly with pelican hooks, anchor roller on bow with hausepipe on foredeck; two bow chocks and mooring cleats mounted on bulwarks; black anodized aluminum forward hatch-tinted lexan; five fixed portlights, one opening in head; black anodized aluminum topsail and genoa track on bulwarks; inboard staysail track, port and starboard; teak exterior handrails, toe rail and cabin house rubrails port and starboard; teak capped cockpit coamings and spindled taff rail; two stern chocks and mooring cleats; flagstaff with base; four 1 1/2" deck and cockpit drains; flush mounted manual bilge pump in cockpit; wheel steering pedestal, stainless steel destroyer wheel, guard, brake and engine controls; 5" pedestal compass; emergency tiller; two engine compartment vents.

**SPARS and RIGGING** — top quality dacron mainsail with slab reefing points, emblem and hull number; dacron topsail; dacron staysail; tack extensions on both headsails.

mainsheet blocks with clam cleat; 1/4" dacron reefing line, 3/8" braided dacron sheets; two topsail snatch blocks; two staysail lead blocks; standing rigging - 1 x 19 stainless steel wire with swaged-on open barrel turnbuckles, combination bow and foredeck light.

— extruded aluminum boom with integral sail track; slab reefing blocks; outhaul tackle and cleat; wire-rope topping lift; fixed gooseneck.

— two primary two-speed cockpit winches with cleats; two secondary single-speed cockpit winches with cleats; three halyard turning blocks on cabin roof leading to three halyard winches and cleats on aft cabin roof accessible from the cockpit; three winch handles; traveller mounted on taff rail with car and stops.
