

Bayfield 40

Built in Canada by Bayfield Boat Yard, this magnificent ketch is a shipbuilder's masterpiece.

At 45'6" overall, with a 12' beam and 21,000 pounds displacement, 8,200 pounds ballast in a moderately long keel carries her 1,009 square-foot rig easily with a 5-foot cruiser's draft. Standard equipment includes sails, Westerbeke 52-horsepower diesel, wheel steering, compass, 11 winches, bow roller, and double lifelines with gates.

Below, the 40 is a living dream—bright and airy with 10 opening ports, four hatches, and traditional skylight. Convertible double staterooms aft may be closed or opened to the beautifully appointed cabin, with 9-foot settee, table, and hanging locker to starboard, and navigation station and galley to port. A stove with oven, hot and cold-pressure water, and


12-volt refrigeration are standard. Tankage is 70 U.S. gallons of fuel, 100 gallons of water, and 70 gallons of waste.

Make it a point to board this boat. Like all the cruising Bayfields, the 40 is something you can appreciate and should experience.
