


Sails are made of polyester cloth (max 180 g/m²) or Clipper Canvas / Oceanus 300 g/m² about. They are cross cut in small width cloth (max 40 cm) preferably of cream colour.

Tack, clew and head reinforcements to be of traditional shape and as discreet as possible. Tablings and sail-ropes to be of same colour as cloth and/or in hemp like rope. No rope on leach. Sewing thread to be as far as possible of the same colour than cloth. Reef pennants in braid rope, unbleached or hemp like.

Mainsail : 13.0 m²
Jib : 4.3 m²
Sail area : 17.3 m²
