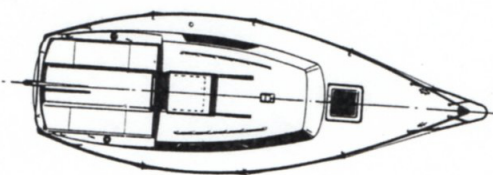
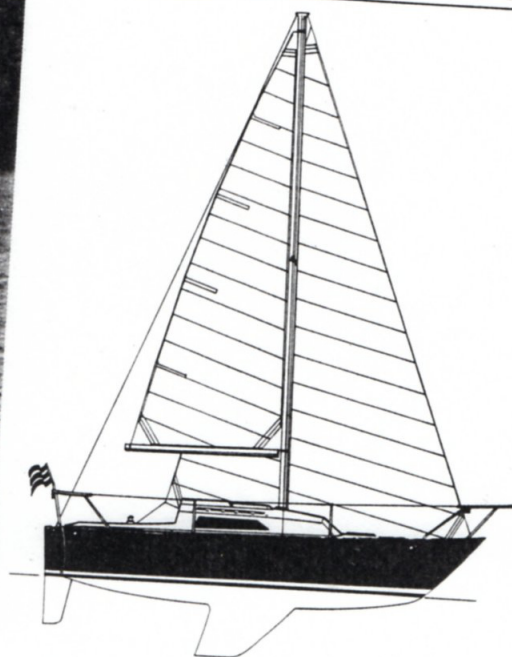

C 24 was created as a comfortable family yacht, ideal for weekend or cruising. There's always been lots of family room aboard.

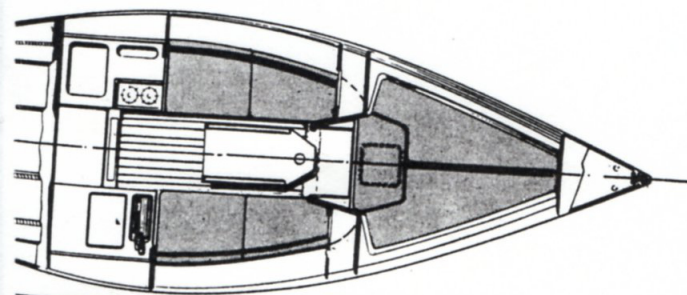
The galley features large food preparation areas, recessed food trays, dish and dry storage, a large stainless steel sink with fresh water integral built-in icebox with drain and a recessed two-burner alcohol

stove. You might well believe you're on a bigger boat. Wide 6'4" settees, for example, convert to a pair of comfortable berths. And you'll find large storage areas beneath the settees too.

A V-berth forward, convenient head with chemical toilet and full-height privacy curtain, forward opening hatch, full-view plexiglass ports, plexiglass companionway hatch and fitted grab handles make the C & C 24 a remarkable solution to the sailing family's need for the basic cruising

boat. So big and roomy for her size, but you'll find the C & C 24 fast on her entry. The hull is sharp and fine for superior rough water performance while the keel provides added stability and wave damping. And you'll find the boat's upwind and downwind performance equally delightful. Cruising or racing, the C & C 24 is in a class of her own.
