



C & C 29

The new cruising-racing C & C 29 presents a slight break with the respected Canadian builder's foregoing line. The new design is light and somewhat lean. The designers say

"The long, slender underwater shape of the hull carries volume well into the ends to increase hull speed for reaching and running."

The cabins provide sleeping for six and there is full headroom. The main cabin has a corner galley with large ice box and nine-inch deep sink. The table is stowed up the main bulkhead. The quarter berth to starboard could be a bunk for two children.

Back on deck, the 29 has the typical C & C T-shaped cockpit. There is wheel steering. An ample locker is to starboard. The foredeck has an anchor well. All halyards are led on the cabin top back to the cockpit.
