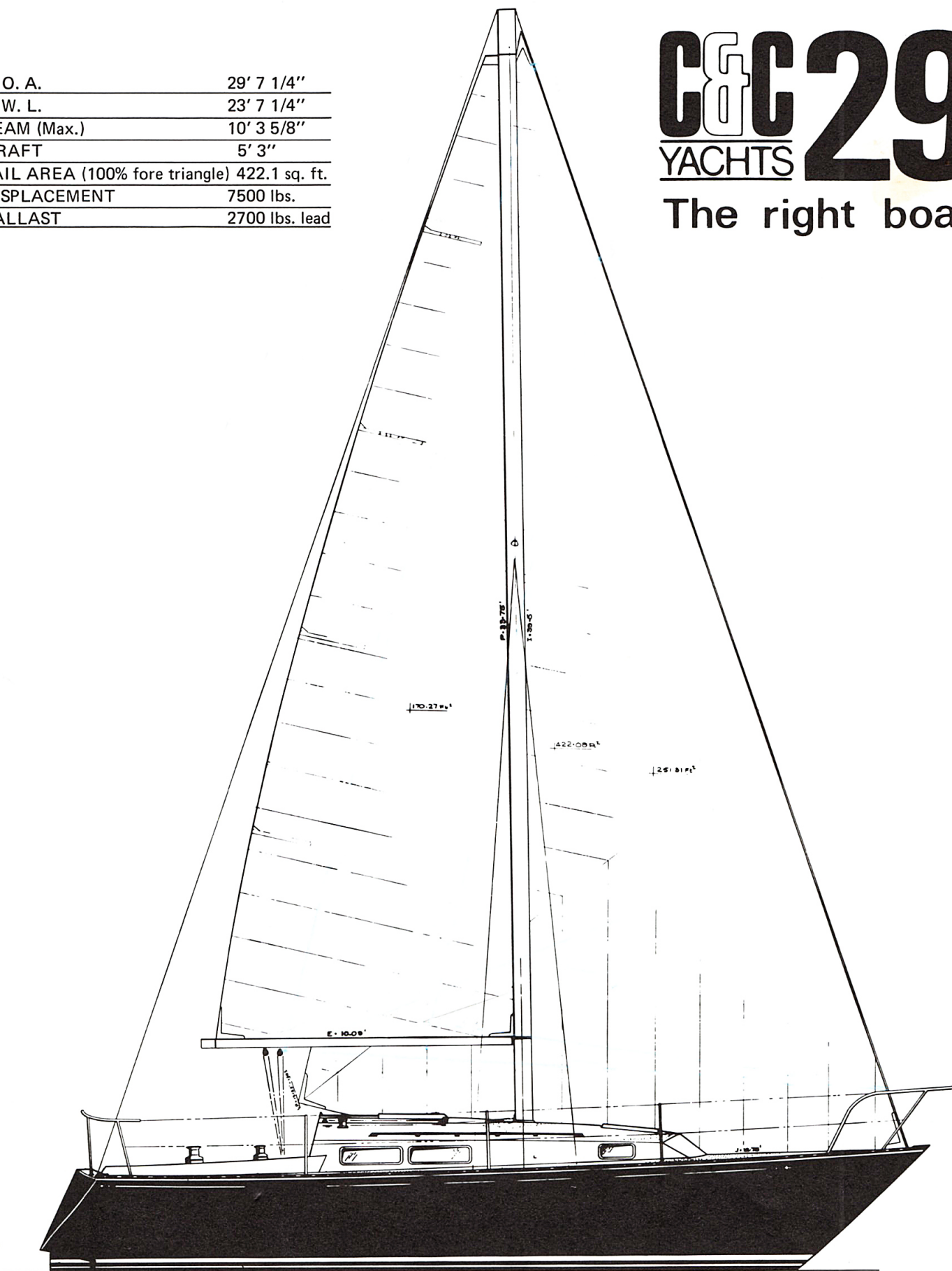

# Specifications/ Standard Equipment Accommodations

## FOCS'L

Light gear stowage.

## FORWARD CABIN

Two 6'4" berths with hinged tops for sail stowage. 4" cushions, fabric covers with zippers. Stowage shelves over V-berths. Two reading lights.

## WASHROOM

Portside - Head with recirculating system and hanging locker outboard. Opening port with screen. Light.

Starboard side - Vanity with stainless steel wash basin, fresh water hand pump. Formica top. Locker with sliding doors outboard of wash basin, stowage under wash basin. Fixed port with curtain wires. Light. Folding door to forward cabin, sliding door to main cabin. Large anodized aluminum-framed foredeck hatch.

## MAIN CABIN

Port side - 6'4" settee berth, 30 gal. fresh water tank under, upholstered backrest with stowage behind. Shelf and locker with sliding doors above and outboard. Fixed cabin table to port side with drop-leaf extension. Fluorescent fixture above table. Two fixed port lights with curtain wires.

Starboard side - 6'4" settee berth with stowage under. Upholstered backrest with stowage behind. Locker with sliding doors above and outboard. Reading light over starboard berth. Two fixed port lights with curtain wires. Carpeted cabin sole.

## GALLEY

Starboard side - 3 burner alcohol stove with oven, remote tank. Deep stainless steel sink with fresh water foot pump. Deep, well-insulated icebox, with sliding tray, adjustable on sliding track. Formica counter top with teak fiddles. Light over galley.

## NAVIGATION AREA

Port side - Chart table with chart storage box, drawers and locker under. Locker with sliding doors outboard. Quarter berth, 6'4" long and 3' wide, with stowage under, doubles as navigator's seat. Four-inch cushion, zippered fabric covers. Light fixtures. Opening port with screen in quarter berth.

## DECK & COCKPIT

Self-bailing, T-shaped cockpit, with four scuppers. Bridge deck with traveller. Deep seat locker to starboard with shelf. Shallow seat locker to port for winch handles, blocks and tackle. Sliding translucent main hatch with spray hood. Aluminum-framed translucent forward hatch. Four fixed port lights. Two opening ports. Anchor locker in foredeck. Life raft stowage.

# Construction

## HULL

Single unit fibreglass, using layers of fibreglass mat and roving, with additional glass in high stress areas. Bulk heads are marine-grade plywood, taped and bonded to hull.

## DECK

Single unit fibreglass, using alternate layers of fibreglass mat and roving. Balsa-cored for stiffening and insulation with minimum weight. Moulded non-skid pattern in all work areas.

## BALLAST

Outside lead fin, cast to high tolerances and through bolted to reinforced hull sections.

## RUDDER

Partially balanced high aspect spade type. Synthetic core with stainless steel shaft.

# Deck Hardware & Rig

## MAST

Aluminum alloy extrusion with integral sail track. Tapered foil section aluminum spreaders. One Barient No. 10 halyard winch on mast. Internal main halyard, 7 x 19 stainless steel wire rope, with rope tail. Cunningham/reef line with dead-eye and cleat. One internal genoa halyard, 7 x 19 stainless steel wire rope with rope tail, led to aft cabin roof. Barient No. 10 genoa halyard winch and cleat. Mast lightning grounded.

## BOOM

Anodized aluminum alloy extrusion, with integral mainsail foot groove.

## STANDING RIGGING

Stainless steel construction turnbuckles with toggles. Split backstay. Fwd. and aft lower shrouds.

## RIGGING

Braided dacron main and genoa sheets. Roller bearing main-sheet traveller. Two snatch blocks. Slab reefing gear.

## DECK

Two foredeck mooring cleats. Anchor locker with hinged lid. Stemhead casting incorporates bow chocks, running lights, forestay link plate and genoa tack shackle. Extruded aluminum toe rails run full length of yacht port and starboard. Two 9' long inboard genoa sheeting tracks, with cars. Two Barient No. 22 genoa sheet winches. Genoa sheet turning blocks. Two Barient plain handles, one Barient lock-in handle. Welded stainless steel bow and stern pulpit, stanchions and plastic coated life lines. Laminated ash and mahogany tiller, flag-staff socket. Manual diaphragm bilge pump mounted in cockpit sole. Teak hand rails on cabin roof, port and starboard. Water and fuel fillers. Waste fitting.

# Mechanical & Electrical

Universal Atomic 4 Stevedore engine with direct drive, two-blade sailor propeller. Fuel temp. and oil pressure gauges. Ammeter. Throttle and shift controls, individual circuit control panel, twelve volt battery and box, twenty gallon fuel tank, deck filler and vent. Water-cooled exhaust system. Bilge blower and vent system complies with U.S.C.G. specifications. Thirty gallon water tank, deck filler and vent. Shut-off valves on all thru hulls. One 2 3/4 lb. fire extinguisher. Bow and stern running lights, interior lighting in locations as described.

## INTERIOR EQUIPMENT AND FITTINGS

Marine toilet with retention device. Remote alcohol tank with shut off valve. Teak hand rails, port and starboard. Curtain wires.
