The C&C 36 follows on the heels of two very successful predecessors — our C&C 33 and C&C 38. The hull's fine, deep forefoot ensures good upwind tracking and ability in a seaway, while the full quarter sections add sailing length when heeled or at speed. These features, coupled with improvement in basic keel design, result in a fast, comfortable yacht.

The deck arrangement features comfortable seating, open coamings and recessed cleats in a basic T-shaped cockpit. The mainsheet traveler, always a toe stubber, has been incorporated in the cabin top to further enhance the spacious cockpit and permit easy movement through the companionway. An anchor well is incorporated in the foredeck to facilitate anchoring.



Down below, the C&C 36 shows a dramatic change for a C&C yacht, with an arrangement which seems to float, broadening the cabin sole area in the galley and main cabin, and allowing more comfortable sleeping and seating arrangements.

The quarter berth and navigator's area include lined dry lockers, spacious chart table and more drawer space for stowage. The galley has a commodious icebox, gimbaled three-burner stove with oven, and a deep stainless sink. The 36 offers a new direction for C&C which we feel will be appreciated by sailors everywhere.
