

# CT-48 Ketch

48'

The CT-48 is our newest sister ship to the well-known CT-54, CT-56, and CT-65. Like her predecessors, she was designed by Robert Perry with a traditional look and respectable performance for world cruising.

The hull form features a relatively shallow canoe body. There is enough beam on the waterline to insure good stability. The stern is broad but very shapely. In the entry waterlines there is a hint of hollow to help the boat to weather.

For this design the ketch rig was chosen to blend aesthetically with the hull. Along with a long fin keel and skeg rudder, the CT-48 should perform well in any wind and provide comfortable stability. This combination proves itself as a consistently good steering boat. The sail area-to-displacement ratio is 15.36.

On deck is a large workable cockpit and there is ample useable deck space fore and aft. The raised cabin trunk provides a light and airy main cabin while raising the cabin sole to sufficiently accommodate an engine and generator. As on her sister ships, the main saloon is entered through a walk-down stairway. The roomy living area is arranged with a fixed settee to port and chairs and navigation station to starboard. The dinette is separate from the main saloon with a pass through to the U-shaped galley.

The luxurious master stateroom aft, with either an athwartships or centerline berth, has a solid teak dressing table, large hanging lock-

ers, and an adjoining head with a stall shower for two. The guest stateroom forward has a full double berth or two single berths with an adjoining head and stall shower. As in all of our CT yachts, the CT-48 interior can be customized to suit the individual owner.



