The newest addition to the Cape Dory Yachts fleet is the Carl Albergh designed Cape Dory 33 sloop.

Like all Cape Dory yachts, the 33 combines masterful design, elegant, full keel with attached rudder and diesel auxiliary power. Her ample beam, carried well aft, produces surprising roominess below in keeping with today's trend toward fuller lines for increased living space and greater interior comfort. Like Carl Albergh's other Cape Dory designs, the CD-33 possesses superb sailing qualities with emphasis on ease of maneuvering and wind handling, windward ability and speed off the wind. Her tall, powerful mast and externally ballasted hull assure her ability to perform smartly in light to moderate air and stability in heavy weather.

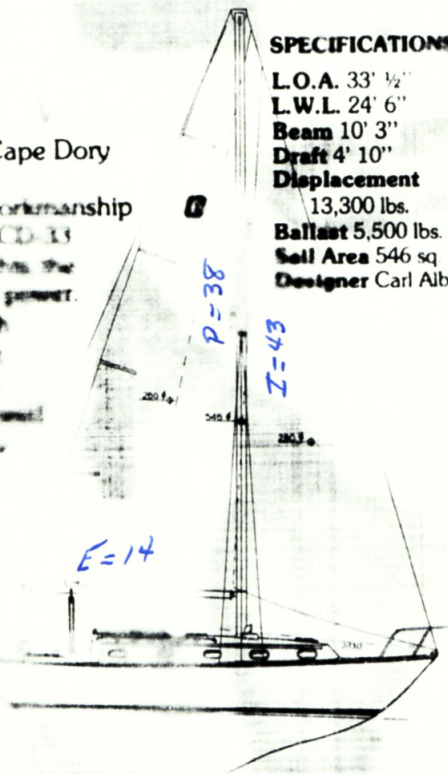
The CD-33's graceful hull lines are accentuated by the warmth of oiled teak trim. Rugged bronze hardware abounds with ten opening ports, oversized mooring and docking cleats, heavy duty chain plates and bow chocks. Inspection below decks reveals a handcrafted interior that sets the vessel well apart from most production boats of her size. In the careful tradition of New England craftsmanship, Cape Dory's woodworkers have used select hardwood and pains-takingly joined to produce a warm and inviting interior of unsurpassed custom quality. Spacious accommodations for six are comfortable and functional.

In this newest design for Cape Dory, Architect Albergh has again demonstrated his professional leadership in developing a vessel combining the very latest trends in cruising design with exceptional sailing and handling capabilities and unusual comfort and liveability. Cape Dory Yachts has continued its tradition of building only to the highest standards without compromise of integrity or quality. The result is an outstanding new product of the time-tested Cape Dory/Albergh partnership. 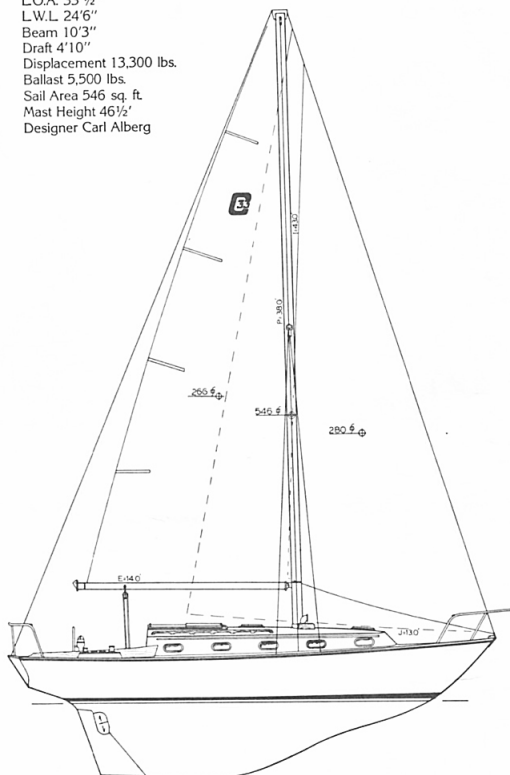
