

CAPE DORY 36 NAVIGATOR

Testimonial by Parker Smith

A few years ago, my wife Sarah and I successfully completed a fabulous five-year circumnavigation on our Cape Dory 36 "Courier". We finished the trip with an extra crewmember - our daughter Keri was born en route in South Africa and sailed home with us up the South Atlantic.

On our long sail we encountered every weather condition imaginable, from frustrating calms in the Doldrums, to perfect tradewinds for weeks at a time in the South Pacific and South Atlantic, to bruising force 9 gales that pushed us a thousand miles in a week in the Southern Indian Ocean, and a survival storm in the Tasman Sea off North Cape, New Zealand. In that storm, we rolled our spreaders in the water twice. After every passage we reached port safely. We anchored off many low sandy islands, up jungle rivers, in busy commercial harbors, and on the lee side of steep underwater mountains, on bottoms of rock hard slate, coral, deep mud, sand, shells and rock, and everything in between. Never once on our trip did we doubt our boat. "Courier" was fast, able, responsive, capable of short-tacking inside reefs on a day sail, and making tough passages at high latitudes. She was probably the best all-around combination day sailer and passagemaker of any boat we encountered on our trip.

Now Cape Dory has greatly improved the traditional 36 with the Navigator 36, a boat we thoroughly believe in and endorse for the serious offshore cruising family. This boat will sail well anywhere and provide a comfortable home at sea and in port, whatever the weather conditions. The standard gear is almost identical to what we had on our boat, and the new features make the boat safer and more capable than ever. And there is no better looking boat in this size range anywhere.

Our advice to those contemplating an ocean voyage in a cruising sailboat is simple. Go now. The World is changing fast. It's tougher to find unspoiled anchorages, untouched islands, and natives unaffected by Western "Civilization". But there will always be unexpected adventures up ahead, unknown islands in unmarked passes through coral reefs, big islands and whole continents you can only imagine, inquisitive people and storms to test your wits, and if you believe in your skills and your boat, you will find them as we did.

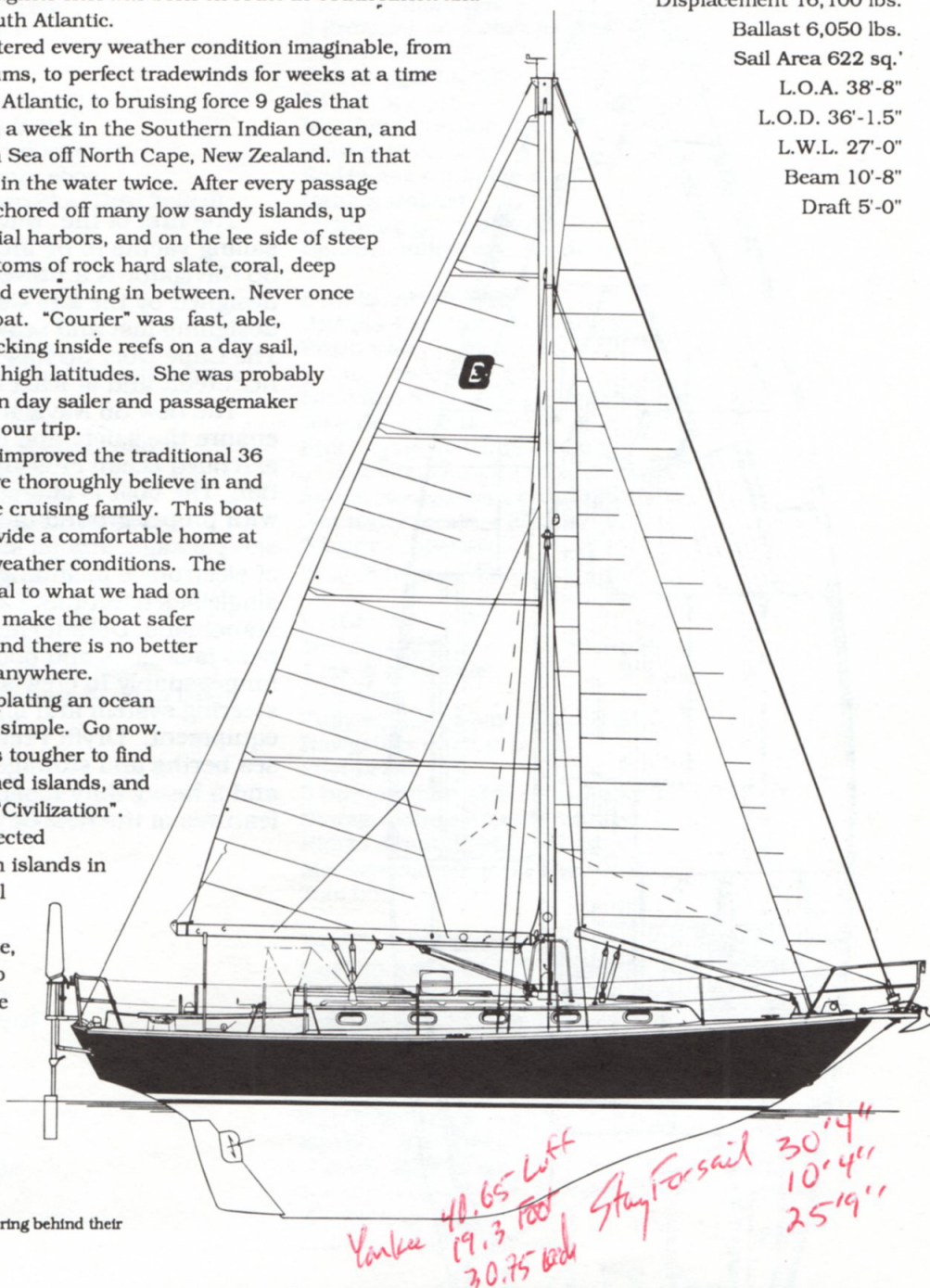

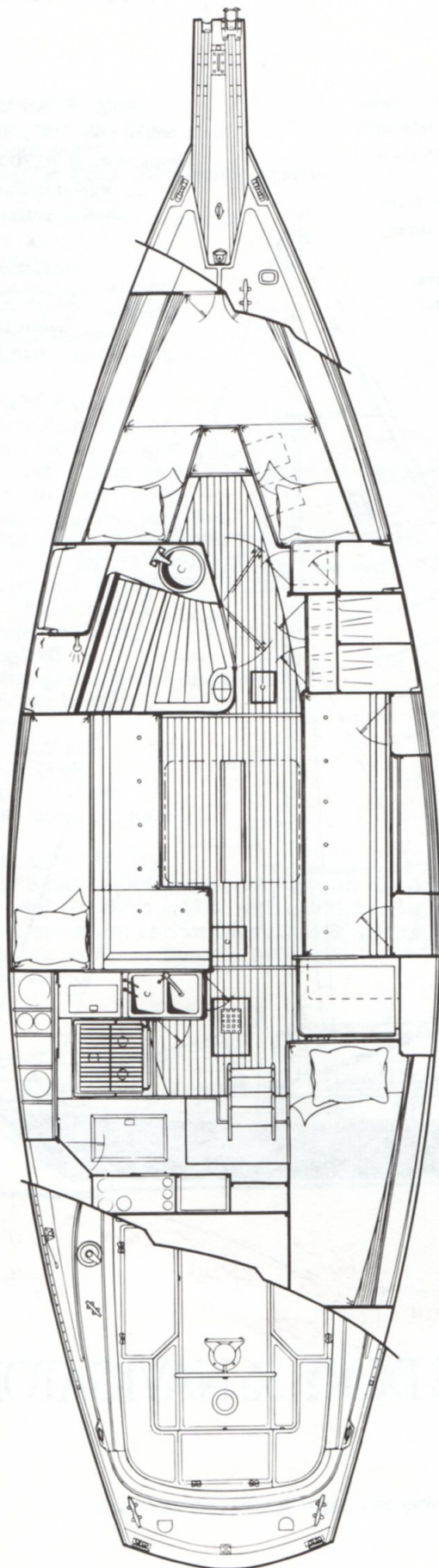

The first of the "Navigator" series of offshore sailing yachts to be introduced, the Cape Dory 36 Navigator is a proven blue water cruiser designed by the late Carl Alberg, a master at designing fast and seaworthy full keel yachts. The Cape Dory 36 has many ocean crossings to her credit and at least one circumnavigation.

The new 36 Navigator is specially built to ensure the safety and comfort of the crew on extended ocean crossings or a circumnavigation. The boat is offered completely fitted out with proper ground tackle, windlass, offshore sail package, lazy jacks, etc., a full complement of electronics including G.P.S. nav system, single sideband radio and more. On deck, high stanchions, Dorade/mast guards, safety harness jack lines and boom gallows add immeasurably to crew safety. A windvane steering system and liferaft are standard equipment. Dryfit Prevailer batteries, proper sea berths and stowage, oil fired cabin heater and a heavy duty tool chest are some of the features of the new Cape Dory 36 Navigator.
