The soundness of Cape Dory Yachts construction invites a careful inspection or survey. Begin with the heavy duty bronze stemhead castings on the bow. **Rugged?** — 10 lbs. of bronze. **Functional?** — Patented locking chocks. Through bolted quality hardware. Heavy duty stay and chainplate fittings with metal backup plates designed to distribute stress into the hull. Extra heavy fiberglass lamination, etc., etc. . . . **Get Our Point?**

Below decks inspection will reveal a full headliner, an interior bunk liner and teak trim which enhance the appearance and provide for ease of maintenance. Accommodations include "V" berths forward, two quarter berths and an area for a marine head. Add two shelves and five storage areas to round out more than adequate (comforts) for a boat of her size.

In addition to the proven design, 900 pounds of molded internal lead ballast offers safety, stability and maneuverability even in extreme weather conditions. A comfortable 6' self-bailing cockpit, roller reefing, and internal halyards leading to the cockpit provide ease of handling whether with a crew or single handing.

The Cape Dory Typhoons generous exterior teak coamings and trim radiate a warmth and beauty so unusual in today's plastic age. Our team of craftsmen are proud of their workmanship. Our owners are proud of the Typhoon's beauty and performance.

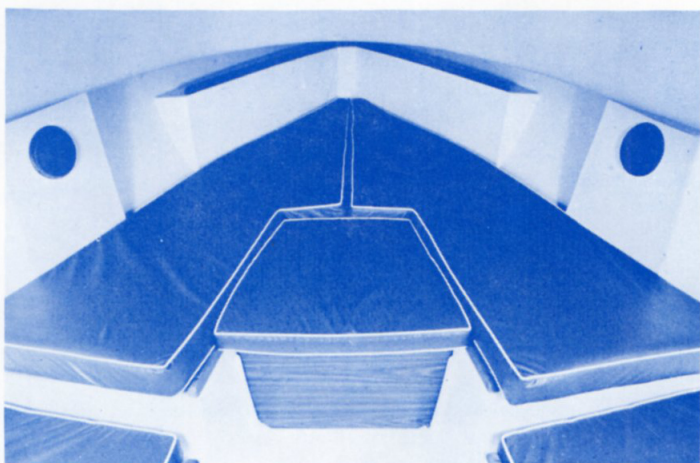
