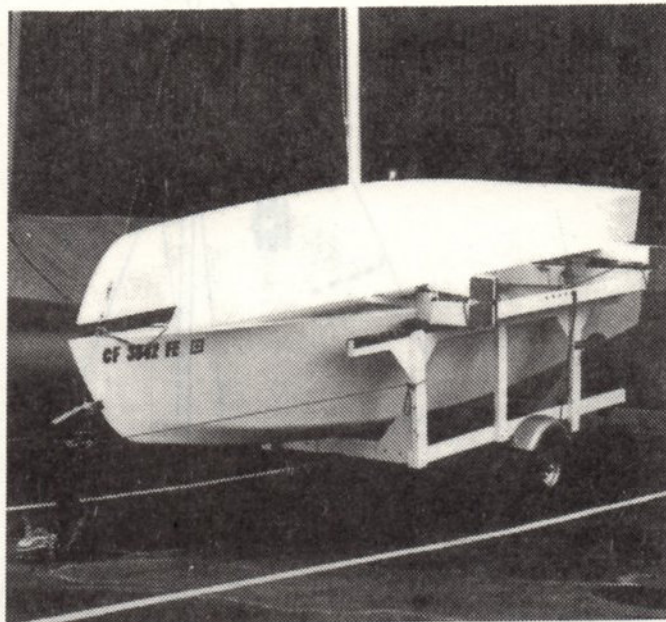


CROSS 18 TRIMARAN SAILING



PICTURE SHOWING FLOATS IN FOLDED POSITION FOR STORING.
MAST ALSO FOLDS FOR TRAILERING.

DESIGN FEATURES:

LIGHTWEIGHT CONSTRUCTION.
WIDE BEAM FOR GOOD STABILITY
FOLDS TO JUST OVER 6 FT. FOR TRAILERING.
LARGE 7 FT. LONG COCKPIT.
VERY GOOD PERFORMANCE.
COMES ABOUT EASILY AND QUICKLY.
CAN BE SAILED BY ONE PERSON.
EQUIPPED WITH DAGGER BOARD AND KICK UP RUDDER FOR BEACHING.
IT IS AN EXELEN T BOAT FOR LEARNING HOW TO SAIL.

CONSTRUCTION:

HULLS: FRAMES ARE CUT FROM 1/4" PLYWOOD USING THE FULL SIZE PATTERNS.
STRINGERS ARE DOUGLAS FIR OR OTHER LIGHT BOAT BUILDING LUMBER.
PLANKING IS 1/8" PLYWOOD, FIBERGLASSED.
DECKS AND COCKPIT SOLES: 1/4" PLYWOOD, FIBERGLASSED.
BEAMS: DOUGLASS FIR.
HINGES: ALUMINUM.
SPARS: SPRUCE (SPAR STOCK) ALUMINUM OPTIONAL.
STANDING RIGGING AND FITTINGS: STAINLESS STEEL.
FASTENINGS: MARINE GLUE AND ANCHORFAST NAILS.

THERE ARE NO COMPOUND CURVES TO MAKE CONSTRUCTION DIFFICULT.

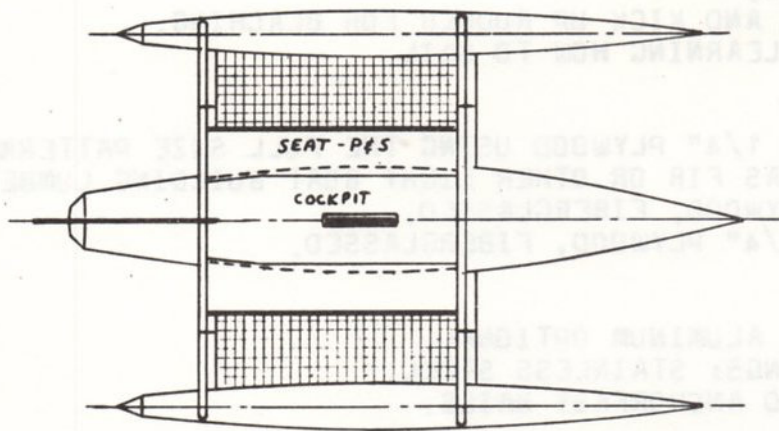
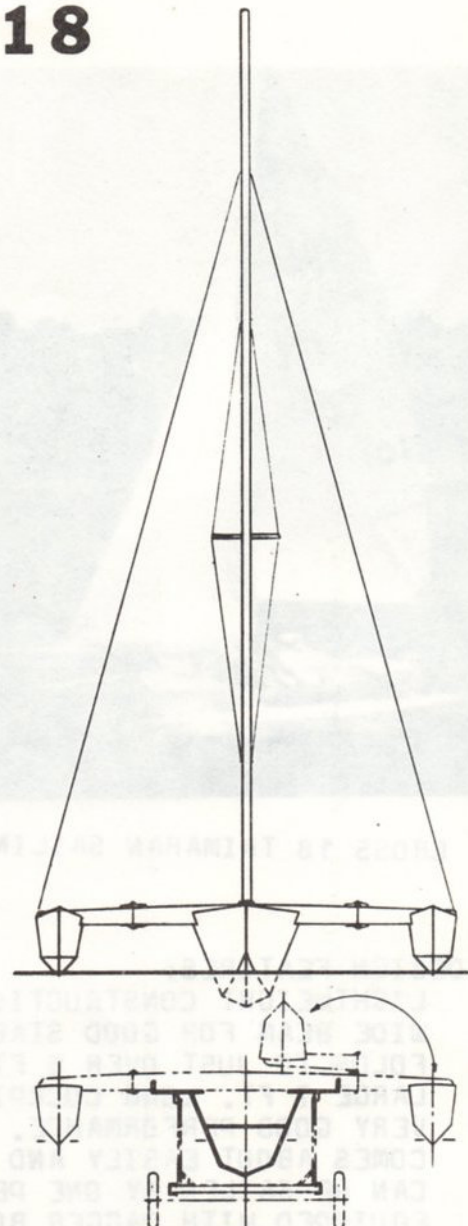
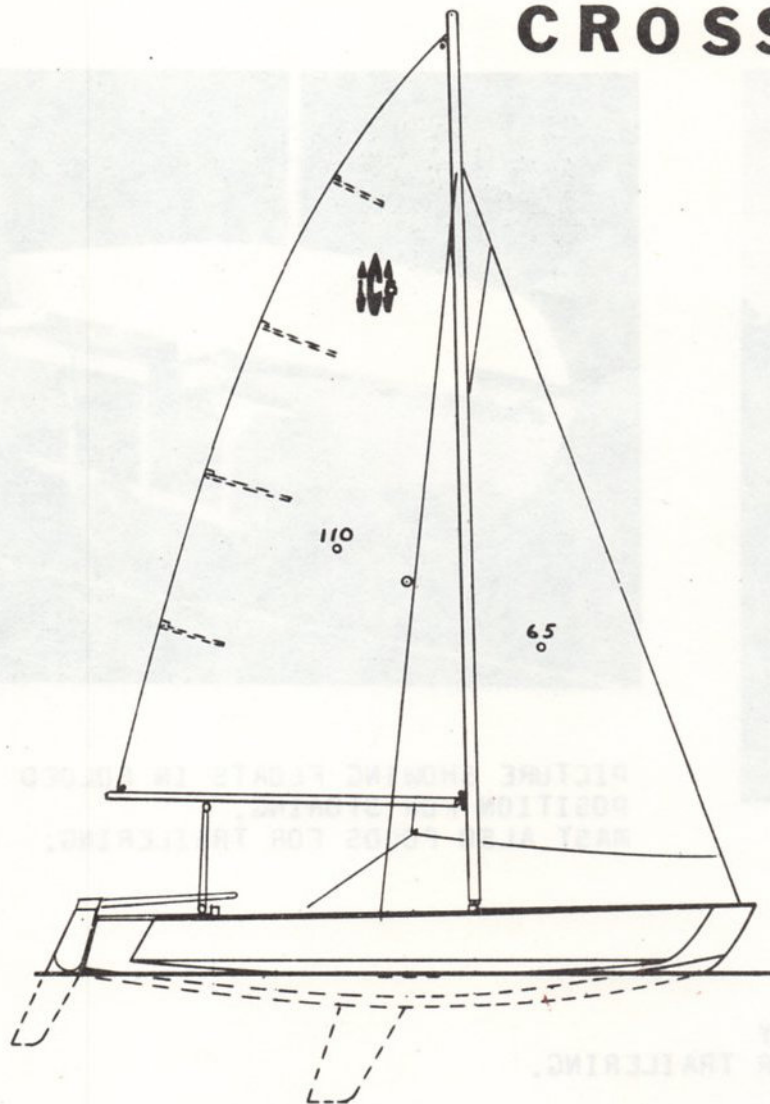
