



It was the first trailerable family boat that's seaworthy and comfortable for up to five people. Countless imitations claim to be good for daysailing, but none have matched the overall characteristics of the original DaySailer that created daysailing. And none, match its high quality. The original DaySailer is unique for its size because it is comfortable, dry, and stable.

The DaySailer is a modern classic conceived by two of the greatest minds in the sport. Olympic Gold Medalist George O'Day set criteria for a forgiving 17 foot family boat, with an enormous comfortable cockpit, high boom for safety, and a protective cuddy for storage and protection from the elements. Uffa Fox, the designer who invented the planing small sailboat, and is the mentor of all great small boat designers, drew the lines for the original DaySailer. The bow has a deep V shape that cuts gracefully through waves, and a flat run aft for great performance downwind. Healthy beam just above the waterline makes the DaySailer more stable than most keelboats up to 23 feet.


