


SAFETY FEATURES


Lyle Hess, noted marine architect, designed the Ensenada 20 with the family in mind. She is completely self-righting even with the keel retracted into the hull. The 550 pounds of ballast provides excellent stability for the safety of you and your family. The large, roomy cockpit has high backrests and easily accommodates five adults. The cockpit is self-bailing, and there's non-skid deck on all walking areas.

The Ensenada 20 is a safe, sensible sailboat that is low in price, easy to launch, trailer and sail, and comes complete with luxury features not normally included in yachts of this size. Whether you're a first-time sailing family, or one who has learned through experience to appreciate the ease and simplicity of a fine design . . . the Ensenada 20 is the boat for you. If you enjoy cruising and fun family races you'll appreciate the regattas and weekend cruises sponsored by a national sailing association. Families in local areas enjoy the camaraderie and learning experience from planned activities throughout the year. Ask your dealer about the association.



EXCITING EXTERIOR

The flush raised deck design of the Ensenada 20 has the big-boat look and feel. The large foredeck is great for lounging in the sun, and provides a nice uncluttered deck for those racing days. **Standard equipment** includes a forward ventilation hatch, teak handrails, safety toe rails, bow pulpit, sheet winches, roller reefing, mast carrier, stainless steel standing rigging and Dacron running rigging, including a main and jib. We even include a cockpit storage hatch and an outboard engine bracket. She's all set and waiting for you!



PLEASANT INTERIOR

The cabin interior is accentuated by the flush raised deck giving added dimensions of space below. Each Ensenada cabin is equipped with a carpeted headliner, a carpeted deck and is fully color-coordinated. She sleeps four adults and each boat contains **as standard equipment**, a self-contained head, privacy curtain, vinyl cushions, window curtains, and a galley with a sink, ice chest and a drop-leaf dinette table and lots of storage. There's also plenty of hand-rubbed mahogany, and the pop-top hatch design provides 5'5" of headroom in the activity portion of the cabin. Your Ensenada 20 contains all the necessary niceties and gets you comfortably underway, **without** a lot of expensive options.

UNDERWAY IN 30 MINUTES

Lyle Hess designed the Ensenada 20 for the convenience of family cruising. The boat is easily rigged, launched and underway in 30 minutes. By following these practical, easy steps, you and your family can be in blue water sailing while the larger, more complicated boats are still at the dock.

Check the chart and specifications on the next page and you'll agree the Ensenada 20 is the boat for you. With its low price and standard features she is ready to go. No need to load her up with all those expensive options other boats require. And the quality construction found on the Ensenada 20 is a Coastal Recreation Inc. trademark. 1.

Arrive at the launch ramp and back the boat into the water. The mast may be stepped before or after launching. (18 minutes)



2.

Slip the boom into the mast, set the rudder on the transom, and hoist the sails. (6 minutes)



3.

Lower the keel and shove off. You are underway for an exciting sail on your Ensenada 20. (3 minutes)





The Ensenada 20 is loaded with comfort and safety features. Check out the chart and compare the advantages listed below with other boats in her price range:

A. Retractable 550 lb. swing keel that provides excellent stability and self-righting capability with the keel up or down.

B. High freeboard to keep you dry and to provide more comfort in the cockpit area.

D. Large cockpit with high backrests which easily accommodates five adults.

E. A race-proven hull constructed of all hand-laid fiberglass.
