



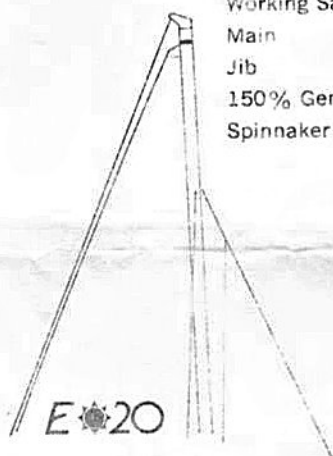
LYLE C. HESS

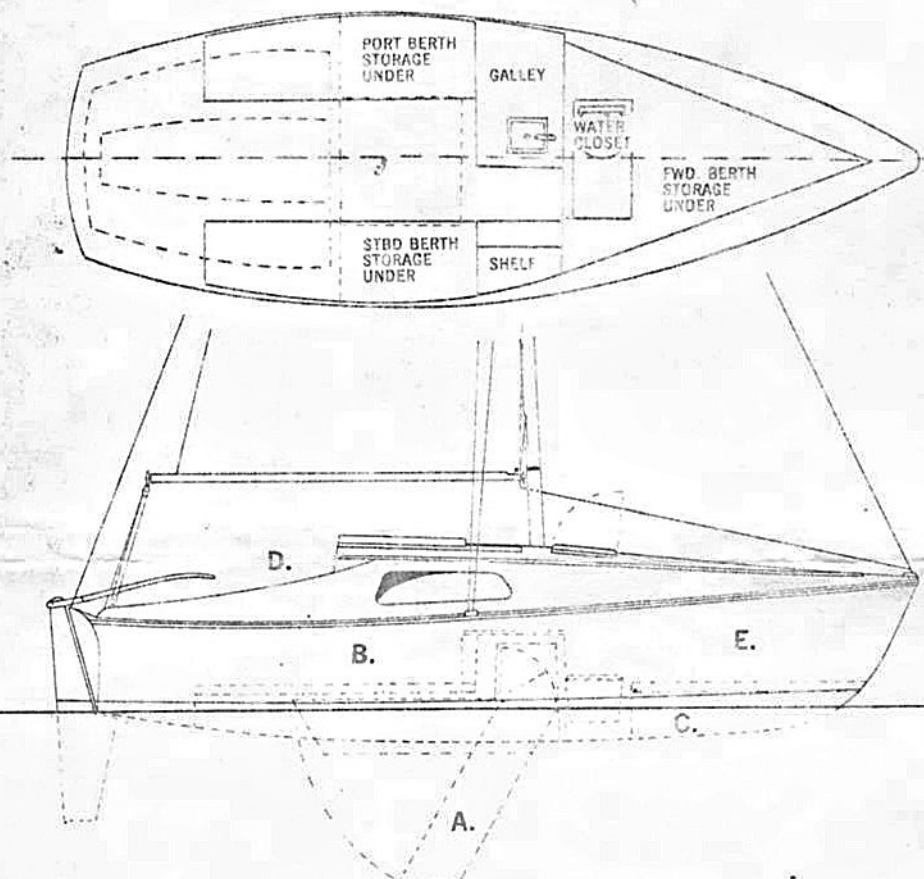
