The New Name of The Game

This is the first 25-foot sailboat to combine so many racing and yachting features in a single, trailerable design. Miniature cousin to the big Ericson yachts of ocean and trans-ocean racing fame, the Ericson/25 comes from the same Bruce King design board and the same Stevens Institute test tank. It is possible that for her size she is the fastest design to date.

Her internal lead ballast is greater than the entire displacement of some other boats her size. Her hydrodynamic centerboard is designed for maximum resistance to leeway, yet when raised it disappears completely inside the hull. Even the rudder can be raised, with optional gear, to reduce wetted surface when running.

With no "pop top" to leak sea water or break down, the Ericson/25 still offers a full 5'6" standing headroom below.

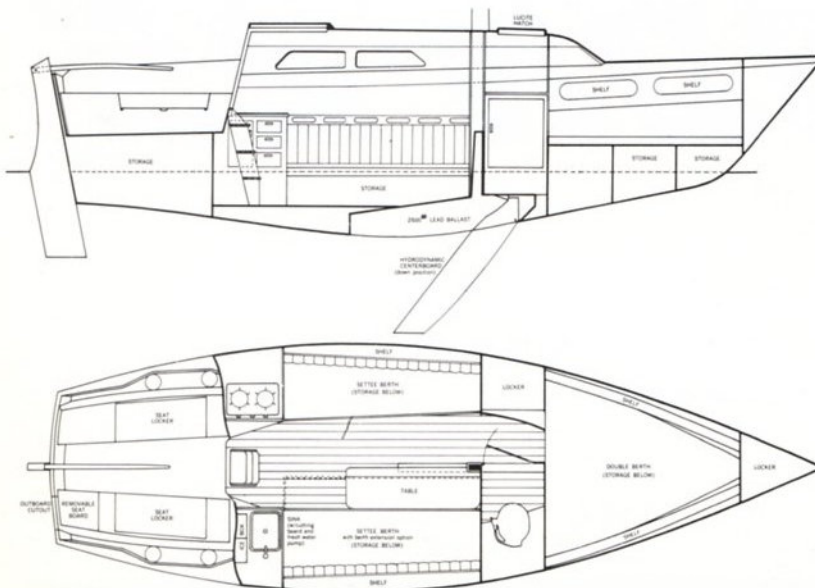
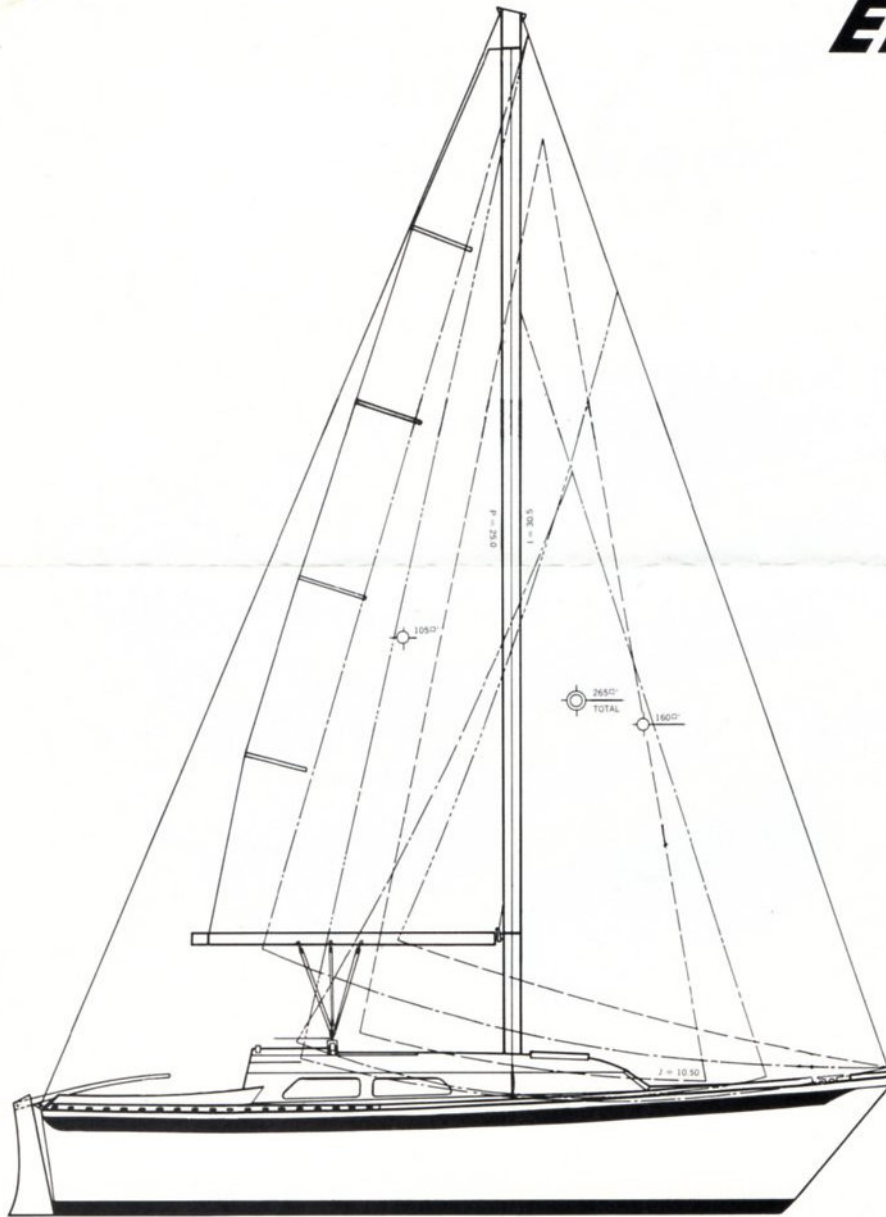
Her open, roomy interior is uncompromised by a clumsy centerboard trunk.

Her enclosed head is truly private, having its own door. She pleases the cook with a well planned galley, a hungry crew with a foldaway dining table, and tired bodies with four comfortable berths (with option for five). She's full of storage places and deluxe details to the same standards as the costliest Ericson yachts.

Because she rests so low on her trailer, the Ericson/25 can be ramp launched in very shallow water. Her mast and fittings are designed for quick stepping,

as well as extra high strength and durability. Her centerboard is raised and lowered by a winch located on the cabin top, the cleanest, simplest arrangement yet conceived. She will move at hull speed with a 6-HP outboard motor mounted in the cutout of her transom.

Think about her. She makes sailing a brand new game.
