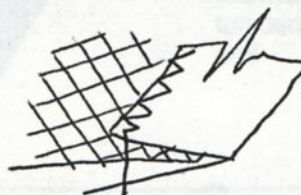
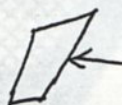

sew webbing to three edges



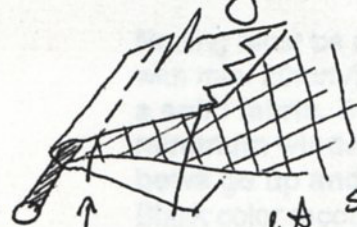
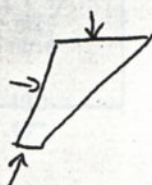

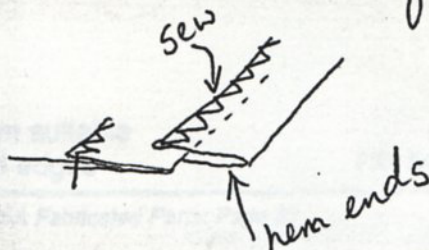
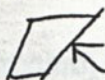
Tape all other edges inserting a boltrope.

as possible.

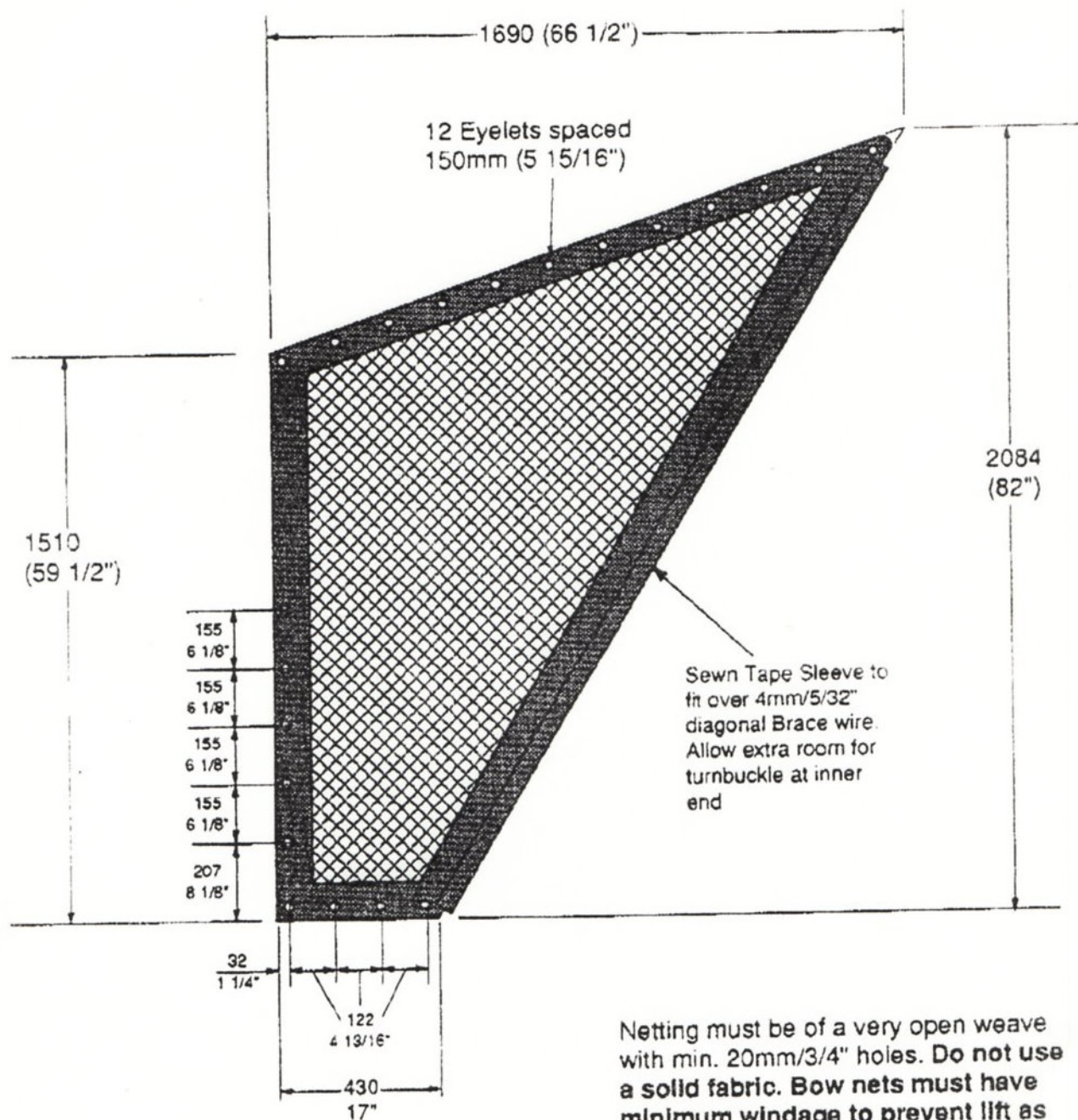

Install grommets as positioned on plan.
Should be placed just inside rope.



All eyelets to be 19mm/3/4" placed exactly as shown

Netting must be of a very open weave with min. 20mm/3/4" holes. Do not use a solid fabric. Bow nets must have minimum windage to prevent lift as bows go up and over large waves. Black color recommended. Usual failure point is eyelets, so these must be strongly mounted
