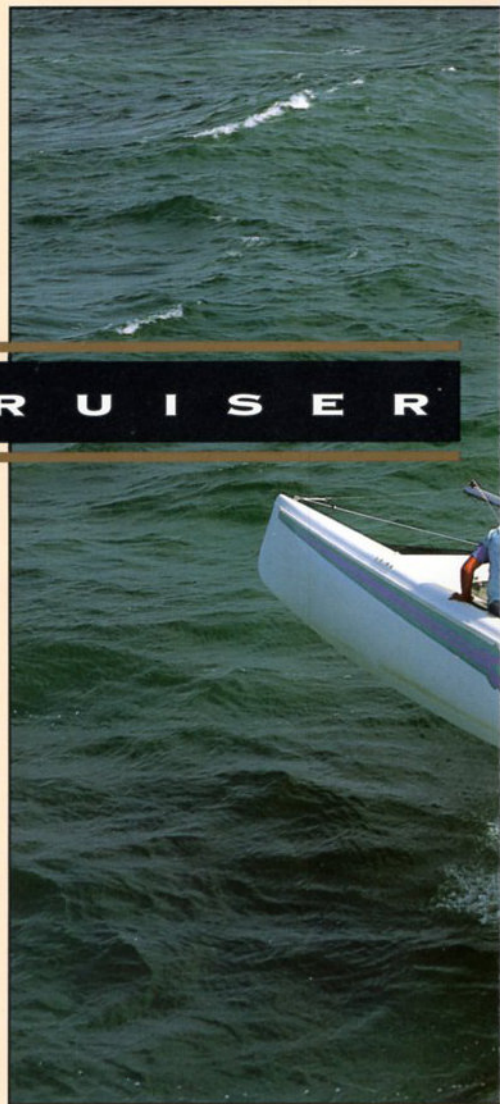

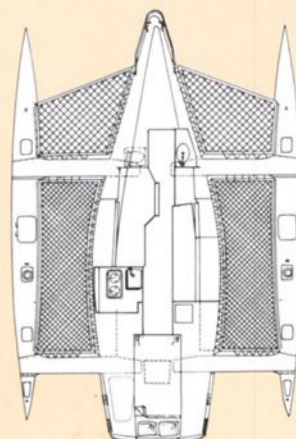
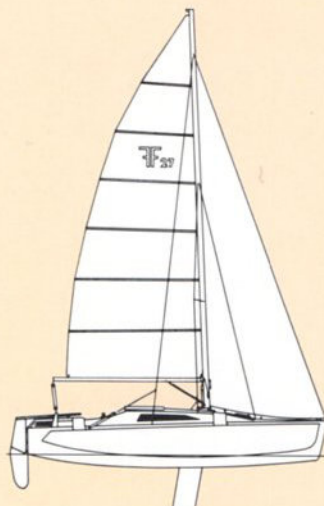

2. Unfolding the floats is done one at a time with no real effort required. Our patented system makes this easy.



3. Single-handed folding or unfolding requires less than 3 minutes and the nets tension themselves automatically.



4. Ready to go, Corsairs may be sailed or motored away. With their light weights, it takes just a small outboard to push you along at 6-7 knots under power.
