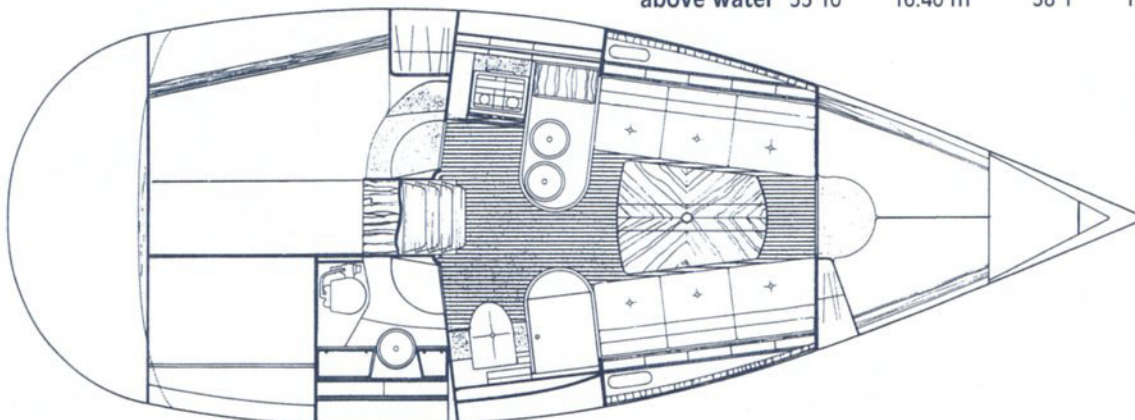

## CONSTRUCTION:

**HULL:** Laminated G.R.P. hull with internal fiberglass hull liner, reinforced with unidirectional rovings

**DECK:** Balsa sandwich for stiffness plus thermal and acoustic insulation. Deck liner for additional insulation and easy maintenance

**INTERIOR WOOD:** Varnished Pear

### SALON
