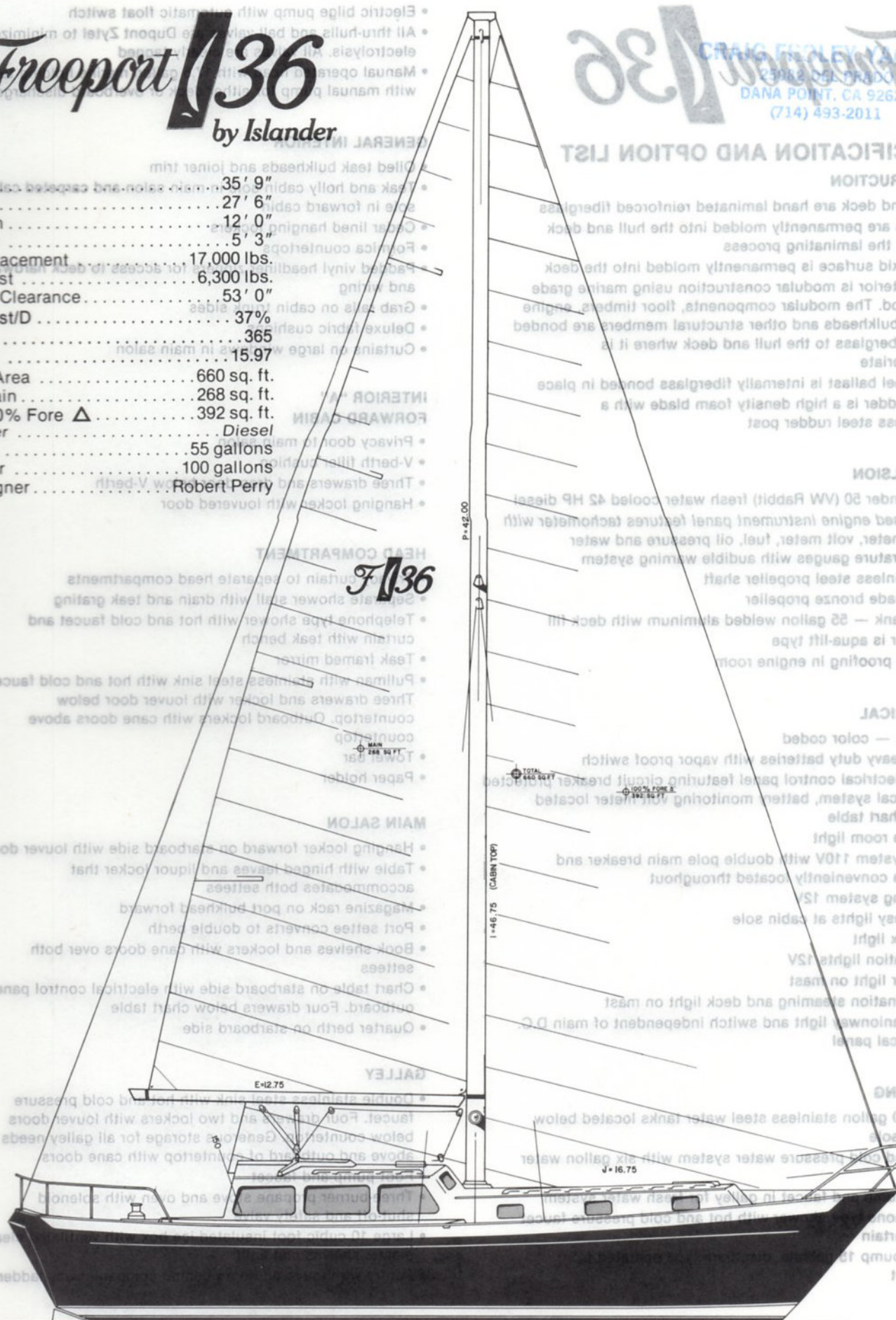

### PLUMBING

- Telephone type shower with hot and cold pressure faucet and curtain
- Bilge pump 15 gal/min. diaphragm type operated from cockpit

- Electric bilge pump with automatic float switch
- All thru-hulls and ball valves are Dupont Zytel to minimize electrolysis. All valves are clearly tagged
- Manual operated head with 17.5 gallon marine holding tank with manual pump for either deck or overboard discharge

### GENERAL INTERIOR

- Oiled teak bulkheads and joiner trim
- Teak and holly cabin sole in main salon and carpeted cabin sole in forward cabin
- Cedar lined hanging lockers
- Formica countertops
- Padded vinyl headliner zippers for access to deck hardware and wiring
- Grab rails on cabin trunk sides
- Deluxe fabric cushions
- Curtains on large windows in main salon

### INTERIOR "A"

#### FORWARD CABIN

- Privacy door to main salon
- V-berth filler cushion
- Three drawers and drop door below V-berth
- Hanging locker with louvered door

#### HEAD COMPARTMENT

- Privacy curtain to separate head compartments
- Separate shower stall with drain and teak grating
- Telephone type shower with hot and cold faucet and curtain with teak bench
- Teak framed mirror
- Pullman with stainless steel sink with hot and cold faucet. Three drawers and locker with louver door below countertop. Outboard lockers with cane doors above countertop
- Towel bar
- Paper holder

#### MAIN SALON

- Hanging locker forward on starboard side with louver door
- Table with hinged leaves and liquor locker that accommodates both settees
- Magazine rack on port bulkhead forward
- Port settee converts to double berth
- Book shelves and lockers with cane doors over both settees
- Chart table on starboard side with electrical control panel outboard. Four drawers below chart table
- Quarter berth on starboard side

#### GALLEY

- Double stainless steel sink with hot and cold pressure faucet. Four drawers and two lockers with louver doors below countertop. Generous storage for all galley needs above and outboard of countertop with cane doors
- Foot pump and faucet
- Three-burner propane stove and oven with solenoid shut-off and safety valve
- Large 10 cubic foot insulated ice box with ventilated clear plastic shelves and light
- Pantry with louvered doors behind companionway ladder



## INTERIOR "B" FORWARD CABIN

- Deep his and her hanging lockers separated by a vanity with five drawers
- Queen berth port side enclosed by louvered doors. Two drawers and storage lockers with hinge down door below berth

## HEAD COMPARTMENT

- Telephone type shower with hot and cold faucet, curtain, teak grating and bench
- Pullman with stainless steel sink and hot and cold faucet. Four drawers and locker with louvered door below countertop
- Two lockers with cane doors separated by mirror above and outboard of countertop
- Large locker with louvered door
- Towel bar
- Paper holder

## MAIN SALON

- L-shaped dinette on port side
- Fold-a-way table with hinged leaves that will accommodate seating for starboard settee
- Starboard settee converts to double berth
- Chart table on starboard side with electrical control panel and a large shelf outboard for electronics. Shelves with louvered door below chart table
- Teak framed mirror in main salon

## GALLEY

- Double stainless steel sink with hot and cold pressure water faucet. Four drawers and two lockers with louvered doors below countertop. Generous storage for all galley needs above and outboard of countertop with cane doors
- Foot pump and faucet
- Three-burner propane stove and oven with solenoid shut-off and safety valve
- Large 10 cubic foot insulated ice box with ventilated clear plastic shelves and light
- Pantry with louvered doors behind companionway ladder

## DECK

- Anchor well
- Anchor roller
- Double rail bow and single stern rail pulpits with double lifelines, stanchions and boarding gates port and starboard
- Transom door that lowers for boarding
- Full length teak cap rails bolted through overlapping hull to deck joint
- Two bow and two stern mooring cleats with chocks
- Recessed inboard genoa tracks with lead blocks
- Mid-boom ball bearing adjustable mainsheet traveler
- Six screened opening ports
- Two Dorade ventilators
- Fiberglass sliding main hatch with molded-in sea hood
- Translucent forward cabin hatch
- Translucent hatch over berth (B Interior Only)
- Two translucent hatches over main salon
- Oiled teak exterior trim and handrails

- Pedestal steering with 36" stainless steel destroyer wheel, engine controls, brake, 5" compass and emergency tiller

## SPARS AND RIGGING

- Aluminum mast and boom with tunnel track
- Mast and boom have a baked-on painted finish for durability and appearance
- Mast head, winch pads, and fixed gooseneck are welded to mast
- Conduit tube for mast wiring
- Stainless steel tangs to receive T-bar type terminals
- Stainless steel standing rigging with swadged fittings
- Internal main and jib halyards with wire to rope splices
- Boom topping lift
- Mast winches, refer to Winch Package under Deck Category
- Anchor light
- Combination steaming and deck light
- Dacron main and jib sheets
