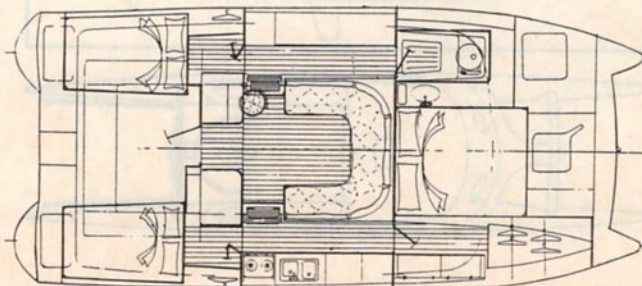
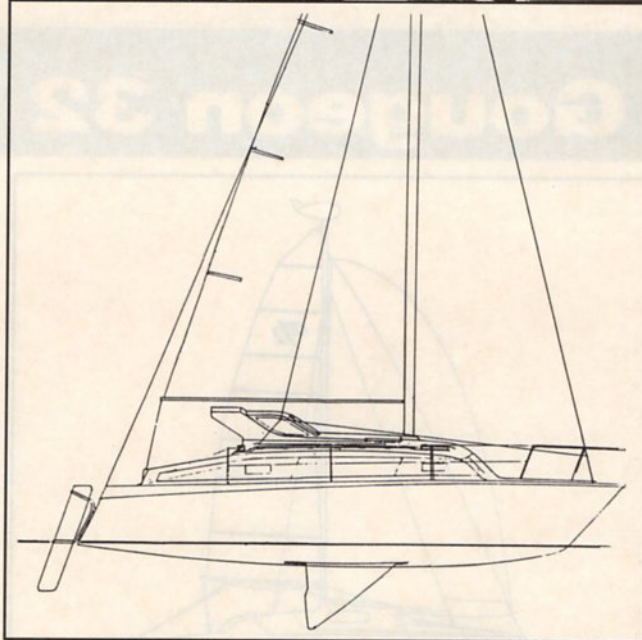
The Gemini 3200 has leapt onto the sailing scene in 1990. She is an evolution of the extremely popular Gemini 3000, almost 300 of which are sailing around the United States. The Gemini 3200 is by far the most popular cruising catamaran in the USA, with production currently being increased to cope with demand.

Accommodation on the Gemini 3200 comprises a queen-size berth, two doubles, a full galley with double stainless sink, propane oven and two burners, a refrigerator and lots of working and storage space; navigation area, and chart table. There is 6'5" head-room throughout the boat. She also incorporates a fully molded bathroom, a larger U-shaped dinette with a folding teak table to easily seat 6-8 people, larger aft cabins, and larger centerboards for even better windward performance.

The mast has been repositioned on the forward bulkhead, strengthening the mast support and opening up the dinette area, and allowing a larger mainsail for efficient and easy shorthanded sailing.

Gemini 3200 draws 18" with her centerboards up, allowing true gunkholing, and the ability to take shelter from storms where no other boat can go. With her centerboards down she draws 4'6". The centerboards are extremely easy to handle, lightweight, and have a pivoting mechanism.

The Gemini 3200 is stable, fast, and close-winded, easily handled, and fun to sail. With her exceptional value for money, she is the perfect cruiser.
