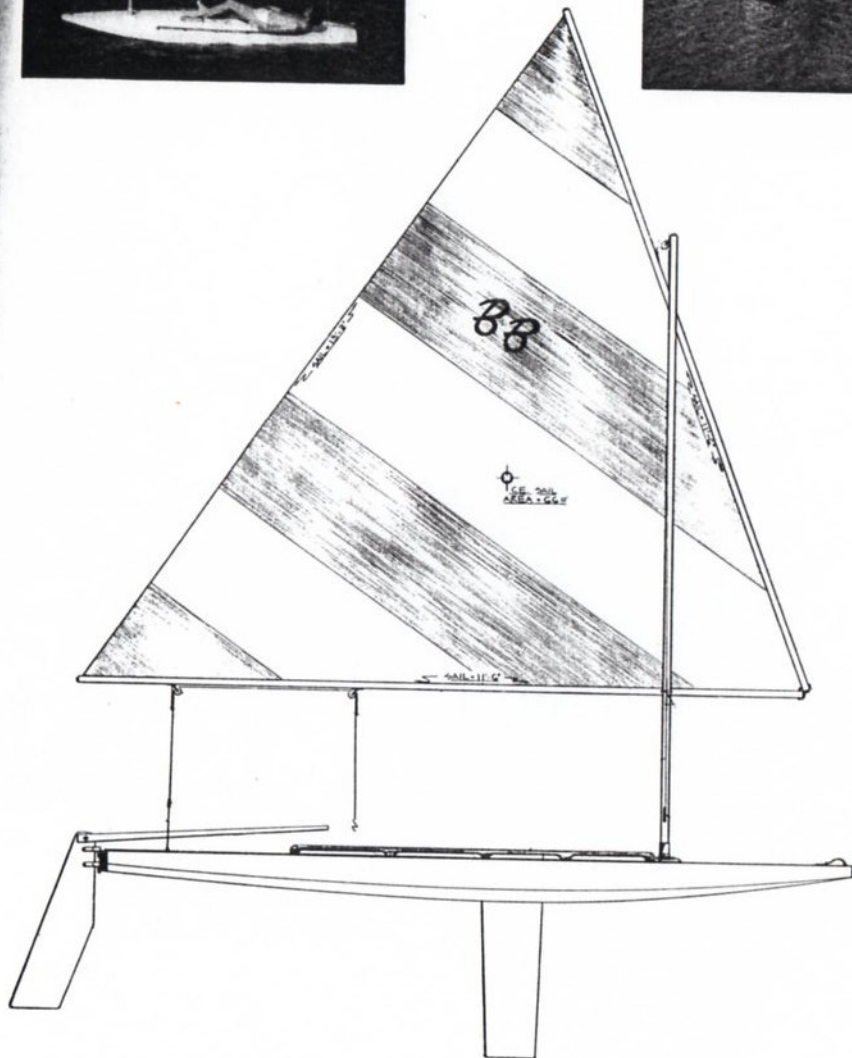
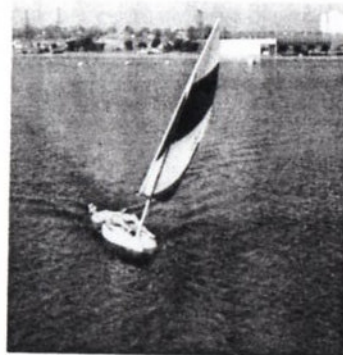


"BUCK BOARD"

CHARACTERISTICS

Length overall 11' 11"

Crew 1 or 2 adults
Hull type: Sailing board intended for plywood planking. Sail type: Lateen type rig with daggerboard.

Ride 'em Cowboy . . . "BUCK BOARD" a rip snortin', rootin' tootin', aquatic cayuse. Put on the swimming suit and go to the local puddle. Totin' the "BUCK BOARD" is simple and it's light too. Rigging is a cinch as you have no complicated stays. As you shove off from shore and unfurl the sail you're in for a thrill. Dig in those spurs and get ready. YeOw . . . Ow . . . Ow. With all of that sail area in a good breeze you really move out skimming over the water and blasting through the rollers. You'll get all the thrills of a surfboard on a downhill run but with complete control. Want to join us? Read on as you too can build this sailing bronco for a couple of "horsefeathers".

"BUCK BOARD" can't be built for a "buck" but then what can today? You will find the hull is very inexpensive to build and simple to construct too. You don't need special material or even more than ordinary tools. No complex building form is required and the plans carry you through the construction in a step by step method. The templates are especially complete being full templates rather than half sections. Complete material listings, types of materials, fastenings, etc. are all given in the complete plan and pattern set.

The sail rig is the basically simple lateen type. This is an inexpensive type of rig that allows a maximum of sail area to be carried without a tall mast and the resultant stays. Then too this type is easily handled for single handed sailing. C'mon pardner, dig down in those jeans and come up with the folding money . . . we'll send the PLANS and PATTERNS back pronto . . . ON THE FIRST STAGE even.

RIGGING & HARDWARE KIT

All of the hardware, running rigging and spar fittings are supplied to completely outfit the boat. All of the hardware is stainless steel while the spar fittings are bronze. AND . . . we furnish ALL of the fastenings required in either stainless steel or bronze. Combined kits consist of 50' of 1/4" synthetic rope for halyards, traveler and main sheet; four stainless steel bullet blocks; five eye straps; rudder gudgeons and pintles; chrome plated bow handle, drain plug; jam cleat; gooseneck for lateen type rig and two bolt eyes; all with the required fastenings.
