

• Design & Construction

Speed—Officially clocked at 23.2 miles per hour—can you beat it?

Asymmetrical Hulls—For sailing efficiency, simplicity and speed without leeway; eliminates the need for centerboards.

Controllable Kick-up Rudders—An exclusive Hobie design that allows positive raising and lowering of rudders by the tiller handle. No need to set rudders by hand. Rudders automatically kick up when beaching.

Built-in Positive Flotation—An important safety feature.

Shallow Draft—Sail and explore anywhere you find 8 or more inches of water.

Light Weight—Weighing in at around 240 pounds, the Hobie 14 is easily launched from beach or trailer.

Fully Battened Main—Provides optimum sail shape for maximum performance.

Overbuilt—Molded fiberglass hulls with vacuum high density foam sandwich construction provides incredible impact resistance.

Less Drag—Unique hull design without centerboards, and a raised trampoline, cut drag to a minimum.

Sail in the Surf—Asymmetrical hulls without centerboards to raise let you sail the surf right onto the beach.

Easier to Trim—The exclusive shape of the hull allows you to trim a Hobie more effectively than any other catamaran.
