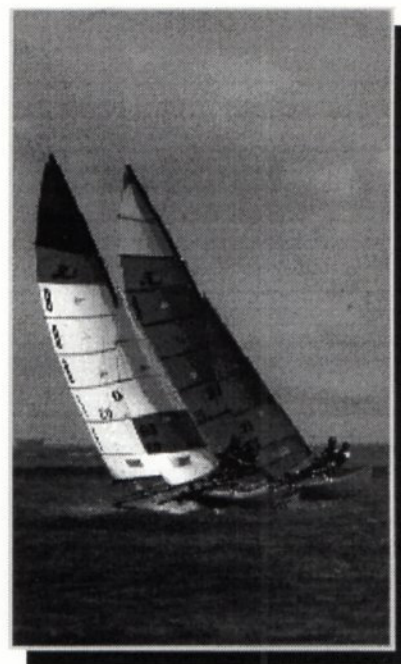


Hobie Cat 16
