

- CONTROLLABLE KICK UP RUDDERS** / An exclusive Hobie design that allows positive raising and lowering of rudders by the tiller handle. No need to set rudders by hand. Rudders automatically kick up when beaching.
- EASY TO SAIL** / Excellent performance and maneuverability even in the hands of the novice sailor, with refinements that are truly appreciated by the sophisticated sailor. Safe, with built-in positive flotation hulls and buoyant mast, it can be righted easily.
- FULL BATTENED JIB** / Helps the bow across the wind and makes faster tacks possible. The unique cam-action jib-blocks allow easy sail handling without the usual jib sheet clutter.
- SAIL ANYWHERE** / 10" draft enables you to sail in shallow water of lakes or inlets and lack of troublesome center boards allows you to sail right up on the beach.

LIGHTWEIGHT / With a total weight of 325 pounds, launching or beaching is accomplished with ease. Handling is responsive and agile.


REEFABLE MAINSAIL / In ultra-high wind conditions or single-handed sailing, you may take down the jib and reef the mainsail.

PORTABLE / Easily transported to any sailing spot on compact trailer or car top rack. Rigged and ready to sail in minutes after arrival.

EASY STORING / Remove four bolts. Hulls, wing, mast, boom and rudders disassemble to occupy a surprisingly small amount of space for storing in garage or basement.
