# HOLDER 14 Mk II

**T**he Holder 14 Mark II is a new generation family day sailer for skippers who want to include family and friends in their crew. Up to four adults fit easily in the self-bailing, eight-foot cockpit spacious enough to hold everything necessary for a lazy-day cruise and lunch, too. Sailors hungry for speed can make their boats fly by adding the optional spinnaker kit.


The Holder 14 Mark II is easy to handle for the novice and experienced sailor alike. Its hand-laid fiberglass and foam core construction makes it strong, stiff yet lightweight so that it skims easily over the water. The hardened chine increases stability so the boat is forgiving without being slow.

Our research and development team has enhanced the boat's performance and convenience by creating a unique, spring-action centerboard and a spring-loaded rudder assembly. The rudder pops up and returns to its down position with one quick motion. Both the centerboard and rudder raise automatically, protecting the boat from damage when it encounters an obstacle.

The Holder 14 Mark II is built to last. Extruded aluminum rub rails protect the boat from dockside damage to keep it looking good over the years. Its teak splash rails keep the interior dry and comfortable. The Holder 14 Mark II is easy to care for. Its Dacron® sails, sewn in our own sail loft, are sturdy and tough. There's a light, high-strength aluminum alloy mast with the exclusive COMPTIP™ mast tip which improves sail control and adds protection from overhead power lines. Also, an optional roller furling system makes for easy storage and quick reduction in jib sail area when needed.

Safety is built into the Holder 14 Mark II. It is virtually unsinkable because of its positive foam flotation, and the double hull construction gives it the capacity to carry four adults, their gear and a small motor. This flotation, plus the light weight of the boat, makes it easy to right in the event of a capsize.







Transportation is easy. The Hawk fits onto the top of most any car. The two-piece mast and the small, lightweight hull even allow the Hawk to travel in the back of vans and small trucks. The Hawk can go wherever a vehicle can go. Maintenance is easy, too. Just a brief rinse with fresh water and a periodic check for worn or weathered materials is all that's necessary to keep the Hawk in good order.

Replacing the top portion of the mast with an advanced fiberglass composite, the COMPTIP provides a wide range of sail adjustment and improved control of sail shape. And, made of a non-conducting composite, the COMPTIP minimizes the danger from contact with low overhead power lines.

### Safety
