

Below deck you'll find a wrap-around windshield to keep the salon bright, two private staterooms, a U-shaped galley and a convertible dinette that serves five or sleeps two in comfort.

Above deck is a lightweight mast with struts, and a B&R rig that spreads the loads evenly through the hull. All lines lead aft to a clean cockpit and combine with a roller furling jib. The cockpit features an integrated arch, walk-through transom and twin stern rail seats.
