◆ B & R rigs are far more efficient, easier to sail, and notably faster than conventional masthead rigs. The need for a backstay is removed by the swept-back spreaders and the diagonals on the B & R rig. Hunter's Child proved this in the recent BOC.

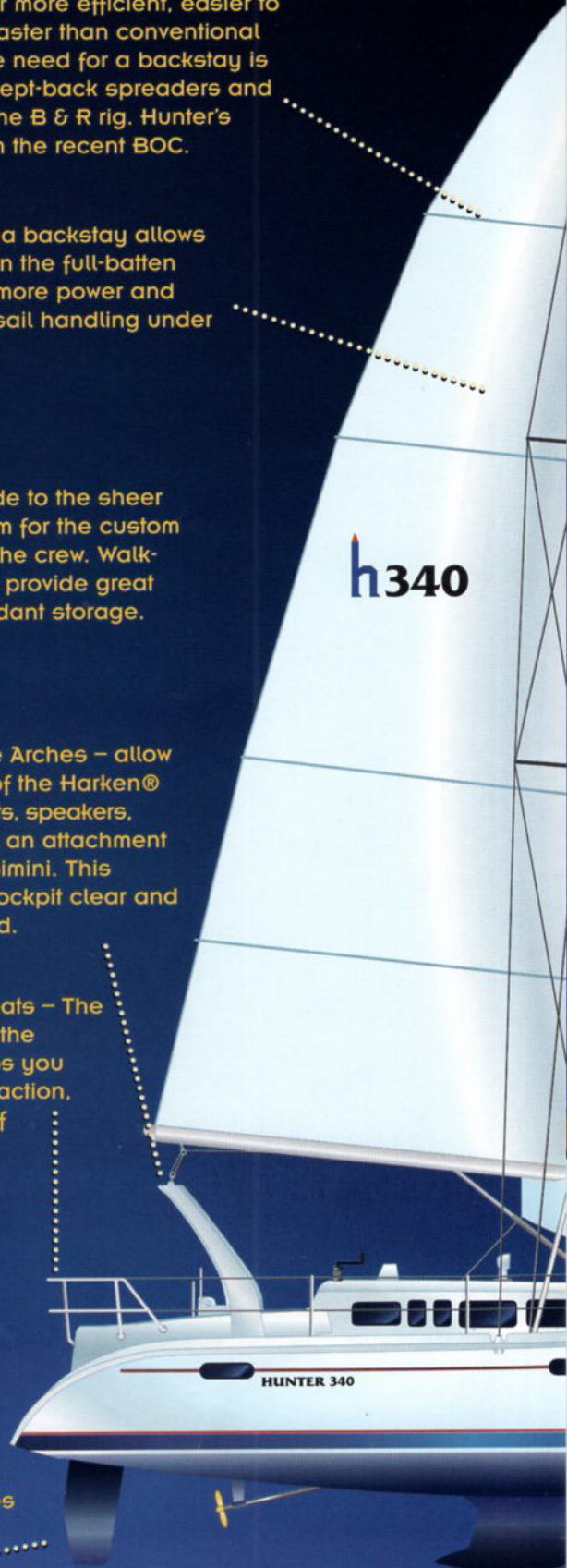
◆ The absence of a backstay allows for a larger roach in the full-batten main. This means more power and more versatility in sail handling under reefing conditions.

◆ Cockpits are wide to the sheer allowing more room for the custom consoles and all the crew. Walk-through transoms provide great access and abundant storage.

◆ Innovative Arches – allow placement of the Harken® traveller, lights, speakers, and also as an attachment point for a bimini. This keeps the cockpit clear and unobstructed.

◆ Taffrail Seats – The best seat in the house; keeps you clear of the action, but in view of everything.

◆ Composite Rudder Shafts are larger, stronger, weigh less than stainless, and are corrosion free. Sturdy Rack and Pinion steering provides great sensitivity and feedback.

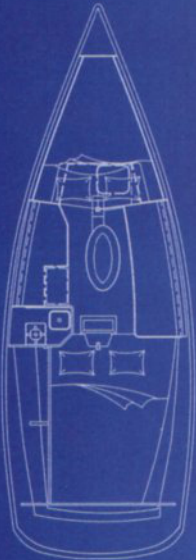

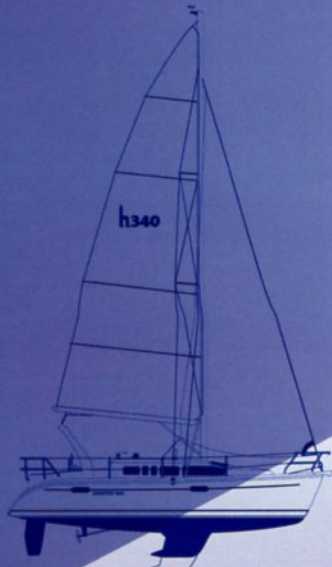

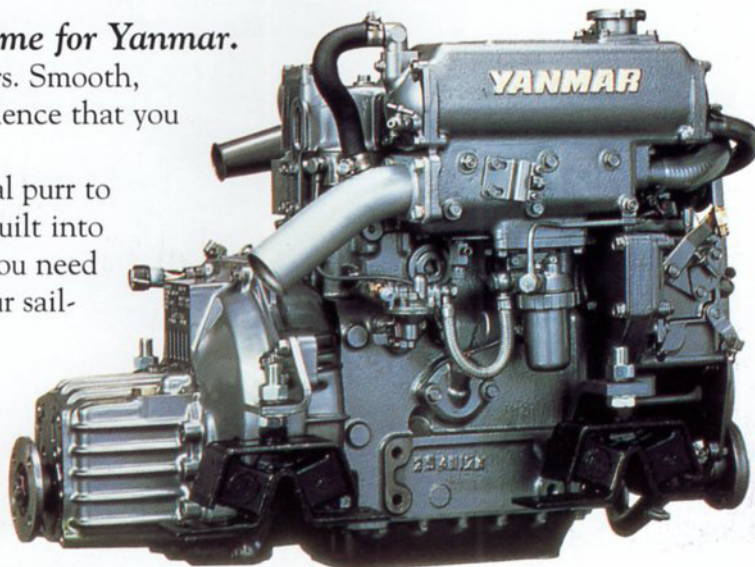
