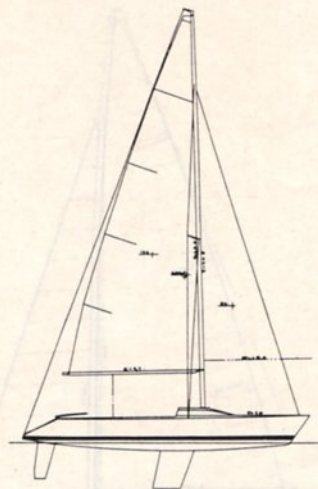
Designed to have the performance of a fast, sophisticated dinghy, the stability of a keelboat, and the simplicity of a daysailer, the Impulse 21 was created as an ideal boat for fun fleet racing while being a comfortable and easy boat to daysail.

For fleet racing, the lightweight planing hull of foam-core construction and powerful fractional rig give her the feel of a dinghy, while the fixed keel and 8' beam give her the stability expected from a keelboat. All controls lead to a center console outfitted with Harken hardware. Harken traveler, jib track, blocks, and spinnaker launcher make sailing easy so crew experience is not essential.

The wide, comfortable decks and 9'-long cockpit provide ample seating for many adults, yet the boat is easily singlehanded. Easy trailerability, transom platform for swimming, deck-stepped

mast, positive flotation, and optional outboard bracket make the Impulse a great family boat.

Impulse 21 combines function with simplicity. It can be raced competitively by two or three average sailors or sailed as an exciting daysailer. The Impulse 21 is flat-out fun.
