

HERE is Tempest, the Ian Proctor designed boat which so completely dominated the IYRU selection trials for a new two-man keel boat. She has been designed for fiberglass construction but can be built of wood provided both weight and center of gravity comply with the class rules. The intention is to make her completely one design. Note the full width traveller for the mid-boom sheeting arrangement. The 495-lb. keel, for trailing purposes, raises like a dagger centerboard and the rudder removes easily. Her lines reveal why she planes so readily in winds of under 15 knots.
