



# The New Islander 30/A Designed By Alan Andrews

Alan Andrews designed and sailed "Details" to win the 1982 International MORC Championships. "Details" is the prototype of the new I-30/A built by Dencho Marine. The I-30/A will be produced to exacting specifications to assure the same winning characteristics of the prototype. Regardless of the wind and sea conditions, the medium displacement "Details" proved consistently superior upwind, and the ultra lights were often awed at the fact that downwind speed was often comparable to theirs. "Details," a division 2 boat, finished frequently among the division 1 boats. This design has also proven to be successful under other rating rules. Most important, she is fun to sail and be aboard with weekend accommodations for six, in two single berths in the main

cabin, and two double quarter berths, and space for a complete galley and a partially enclosed head.
