The 1993 Model J/24 is the best ever with new non-skid deck for better traction, less wood for easier maintenance (J/24 sailors prefer to sail), moulded V-berth air tank for greater safety, precise keel placement, the latest deck layout for optimum sailing efficiency, and a one piece hull mould and faired blades to reduce race preparation time. While some of the world's best sailors have already placed their orders for the newest J/24, a well-prepared 1977 model, built to the same shape and weight with rigid Baltek cored construction can still win the worlds even after 30,000+ miles of trailering. That's "one-design".

J/24 is for everyone, age 12 to 80, no matter what their style: racing, daysailing, or cruising. Her flared topsides make her dry on deck. Her "weekender" cabin makes it possible to get warm on cold days and she can be sailed easily by one person with only the mainsail. In addition to the International Yacht Racing Union's Land Rover Nation's Cup, the J/24 is the US National Junior Championship (Sears Cup) sloop for 1992, the Rolex Women's International Keelboat for 1993 and the St. Francis International Masters Championship (aged 55+) selection for 1992.

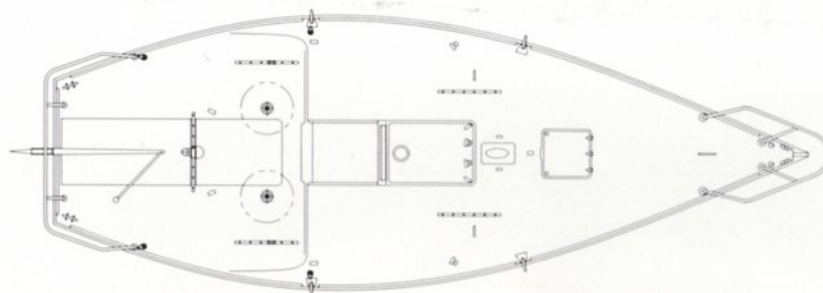
The International J/24 is the only offshore one-design sanctioned for world competition.
