The Genius of Rodney Johnstone.

Rod Johnstone, one of the world's most imaginative and prolific sailboat designers, is the brain behind the

JY 15®. Starting with *Ragtime*, the prototype J/24 built in his garage in 1975, Rod has given sailors 18 successful production offshore designs. In 1990, the readers of *Sail* magazine hailed him as one of three designers in the past twenty years to change the course of sailing.

Back to Basics in a High-Tech Way.

Rodney Johnstone's JY 15 is a tower of simplicity and strength, a boat as beautiful to look at as it is to sail. Underlying its purity of form and function is a high-tech composite structure that has started a revolution in small boat building.

JY 15 introduces a patented process which transforms multilayered plastic into a composite hull which combines: the impact resistance of plastic, the strength of fiberglass, and the flotation and rigidity of foam. This results in a composite structure which delivers the strongest high-performance sailing dinghy ever built. Every JY 15 hull is exactly the same as every other, a clone, all made in the same way, in the same facility. It all adds up to a durable sailboat requiring less maintenance. Strength and stiffness mean a longer competitive life, and the uniformity of shape and weight so important for true one-design performance.

Comfort and Safety.

It's reassuring to know that the beauty of a JY 15 is more than skin deep. Beneath the triple-laminate skin is a solid foam core, bonded to a layer of fiberglass, the ultimate in safety and strength. When Rod Johnstone designed this boat, he did it with you, the sailor, in mind. How you like to sail... the fact that most sailors aren't gymnasts. There is no joy in a bumped head, bruised shins, a sore back. Rod eliminated hard corners. He designed a low profile centerboard, high boom, a self-bailing cockpit, and gave the JY 15 a wide, safe beam.

The greatest comfort of all is a stable, comfortable boat, a safe boat with great acceleration and easy controllability. Equally comforting is owning a family-friendly sailboat, giving hours of pleasure, at a sport where the hours seem to condense into minutes.

CONSTRUCTION

> Innovative
Patented Composite
Construction:

- Thermoformed plastic laminate outer skin of impact-resistant structural ABS, weatherable UV-resistant protective layer and abrasion-resistant, non-chalking acrylic finish.

- 3/4" high density polyurethane closed cell foam core, injection molded and bonded in matched tooling to provide rigidity and 900 lbs. positive flotation.

- Glass reinforced polyester inner skin completes the composite for greater overall strength.

- > Full length fore & aft glass reinforced structural omega beam and two structural foam bulkheads to prevent hull deflection under load.

- > 3" epoxy bonded rolled edge hull and deck joint.

- > Self-draining cockpit with under-deck dry storage.

- > High density, composite, steel-reinforced swing-up rudder and centerboard

- > Low profile centerboard trunk.

- > Ergonomically contoured cockpit and decks.

DECK HARDWARE & RIGGING

- > 1/8" 7x9 stainless wire shrouds & headstay.

- > Johnson shroud adjusters and forestay tensioning lever provide quick set-up and rig adjustment.

- > Two-piece Dwyer DM-2 section mast with custom splice for easy transport.

- > A 2:1 Harken main sheet system with swivel base mini hexratchet block and cam cleat mounted on centerboard trunk.

- > Harken mini hexratchet jib sheet blocks.

- > Four-part Harken Vang system/integral V-jam cleat.

- > Ronstan X-10 removable tiller extension with Hyperion grip and lifetime guaranteed urethane universal joint.

- > Anodized aluminum rudderhead and tiller.

- > Separate nylon hiking straps for skipper and crew.

OPTIONS

- > Smaller Delta mainsail with foam flotation pad at headboard to minimize the chance of capsize.
