J/92 Specifications

Hull & Deck

- Lloyd's approved, end-grained balsa construction using biaxial and unidirectional E-glass for optimum strength. Interplastic vinylester resin for a 10 year hull blister warranty.
- Innovative, lightweight and strong hull/deck joint bonded with 3M polyurethane elastomer bonding agent and finished with 3M 5200.
- White gel coat hull with tapered molded bootstripe & **J/logo decal on aft hull corners.**
- Large open racing cockpit with raised 2" coaming, low profile mainsheet traveler on sole, high traction non-skid, and optimized hardware layout.
- Large companionway opening with light weight molded seahood and curved slider.
- GRP molded main structural bulkhead, bonded to hull and deck providing superior support for shroud chainplates and optimum hull & deck stiffness.
- Individually bonded light-weight structural bulkheads.
- Individually bonded FRP fiberglass structural keel support grid.
- Aluminum mast step "I" Beam with transverse beams fastened to main bulkhead and structural support grid.
- Lead & antimony fixed 5.9' draft bulb keel for low CG, bolted, epoxy bonded and glass wrapped to deep reinforced structural hull stub.
- 1.25" toe rails on foredeck.

Power & Steering

- Yanmar 9 h.p. 1 cylinder diesel engine with water, dirt, and fuel filters.
- Engine instrument panel in cockpit with tachometer and alarms for oil pressure and temperature.
- Balanced, light weight, high aspect spade rudder with carbon fiber shaft turning on two teflon rudder bearings.
- Varnished, curved, & laminated mahogany tiller with stainless steel straps and Spinlock adjustable hiking handle.
- Lightweight, low profile, stainless rudder head fitting.
- 12 gallon fuel tank with inspection port, gauge, and shut-off valve.
- Martec **13 X 11** folding bronze prop with 3/4" Aquamet S.S. shaft and molded custom strut.

- Two Harken 40.2A 2 speed primary cockpit winches.
- Two Harken 32.2A 2 speed secondary winches for halyards, reef lines, and spinaker sheeting.

- Lexan companionway drop board with inside/outside opening, lockable stainless hasp.
- Two single 10" Antal aluminum lock-in winch handles w/roller bearing handles.
- Henderson Cockpit Operated Bilge Pump.
- Two PVC winch handle holders.
- **Two plastic cowl vents for bow & stern.**
- Double white PVC coated lifelines.

Spars & Rigging

- Hall Spars 152 6061-T6 aluminum aerodynamic mast section, w/tapered upper panel, double tapered spreaders, welded masthead crane, internal halyards, wire halyard exits w/s.s. chafe bars, cast aluminum mast shoe, mast collar w/custom fit boot and wedges. Mast & boom finished with off-white awlgrip.
- Stainless 1x19 wire headstay, upper, lower and intermediate shrouds with open body adjustable turnbuckles, and backstay.
- Main halyard of 7x19 stainless wire spliced to 3/8" XLS white code dacron tail with headboard shackle.

- **Jib halyards P&S** of 7x19 stainless wire with Nicro snap shackles spliced to 3/8" XLS solid red and blue code dacron tails.
- **Cockpit line storage bags.**
- Harken Model O Roller Furler.
- Spinnaker halyard of 3/8" XLS solid blue code dacron with Nicro snap shackle.
- Bow Sprit retrieval system of 5/16" shock cord and Harken blocks. 5/16" XLS blue code dacron sprit control line leading from below decks to cockpit mounted Harken 150 cam cleat on cabin trunk.
- **Spinnaker tack line of 3/8" XLS red code w/whipped ends leading to a Harken cam cleat aft to starboard on cabin trunk just above the pole control cam-cleat.**
- Double ended Harken adjustable cascading backstay purchase with 5/16" XLS solid red braid leading to Harken 150 cam cleats on cockpit well to port and starboard.
- **4:1 Harken double ended cunningham purchase with stainless grommet hook, 5/16" solid red control line, & vinyl coated wire strop leading to cam cleat on forward corners of seahood.**
- 8:1 Harken boom vang system with 3/8" XLS white w/blue fleck control line
- Harken hexaratchet 6:1 mainsheet system including swivel base cam and dual boom bales.
- Stainless steel chainplates for shrouds and backstay bolted to main bulkhead and transom.
- Main boom with 1 reef line, 6:1 internal outhaul tackle, welded vang lug, goose-neck end fitting with tack reef hooks and reef cleat.

Interior

- Low maintenance molded interior finish with teak & holly varnished sole, and easy to clean off-white interior bulkheads.
- 6"5" main cabin settees with comfort molded backrests and shelf with teak fiddle.
- Choice of standard cushion colors on main cabin settees.

- Storage compartments below settees.
- Stainless companionway ladder w/teak treads.
- 48 quart carry-off Rubbermaid cooler with positive tie down system.

J/92 combines the elements for one-design success with a lasting design that encourages participation.

There are three criteria important for one-design success which the J/92 fulfills, but which are often overlooked: (1) Is there a grace to the look of the boat that is captivating? (2) How easy and how much fun is it to sail with family and friends? (3) Will this boat expand one's circle of sailing friends?

Rod Johnstone designed the J/92 for family participation. Her great stability and highly efficient systems make it easier to sail with a few people you care for, instead of a gang of specialists you need for crewing on conventional designs. Running backstays, spinnaker pole, pole lift, foreguy, afterguys, grinders, tailers, genoas... gorillas on the rail: They're gone. J/92 Class Rules specify a 3 sail

limitation: Dacron mainsail, 100% roller furling Mylar jib and .75 oz. Nylon asymmetric spinnaker. The crew weight limit is 4 people of any weight, or 880 lbs. if 5 or more people. You hardly need a winch to tack the 100% jib or jibe the asymmetric spinnaker. It's so easy!

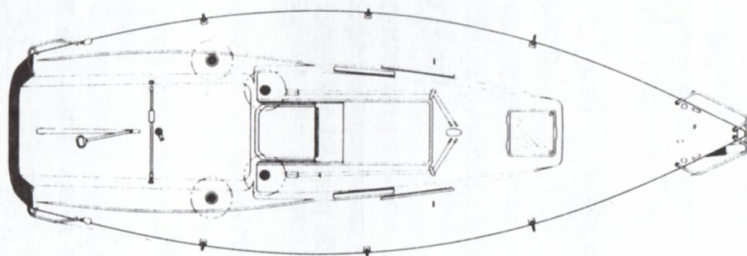
