

Sail to be cut with a generous belly.
Use polyester cloth 160 g/m² about
or Clipper Canvas / Oceanus 300 g/m² about.
Sail is cut in small width cloth (400 mm about),
preferably of cream or light tan colour.
Tack, clew, head and reef reinforcements to be of
traditional shape and as discreet as possible.
Tablings and sail ropes to be of same colour as
cloth or in hemp like rope.
Sewing thread to be as far as possible of the
same colour than cloth.
Reef pennant in braid rope, unbleached or hemp like.
