Why bob like a cork when you can glide over the water on a Laser 2?

If you are searching for a responsive two person boat with sparkling performance, there is only one choice. The Laser 2 is the daysailer that's invigorating to sail. The cockpit has plenty of room and is designed for comfort regardless of sitting positon. Sprawl out in the middle of the cockpit, or sit comfortably on the side decks. If you really want to go for it, there's always the trapeze to hang over the water for some real excitement!
