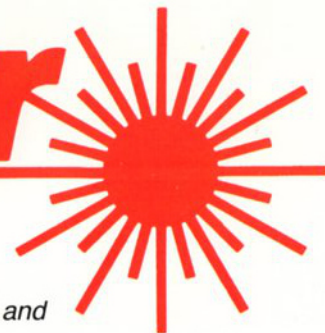

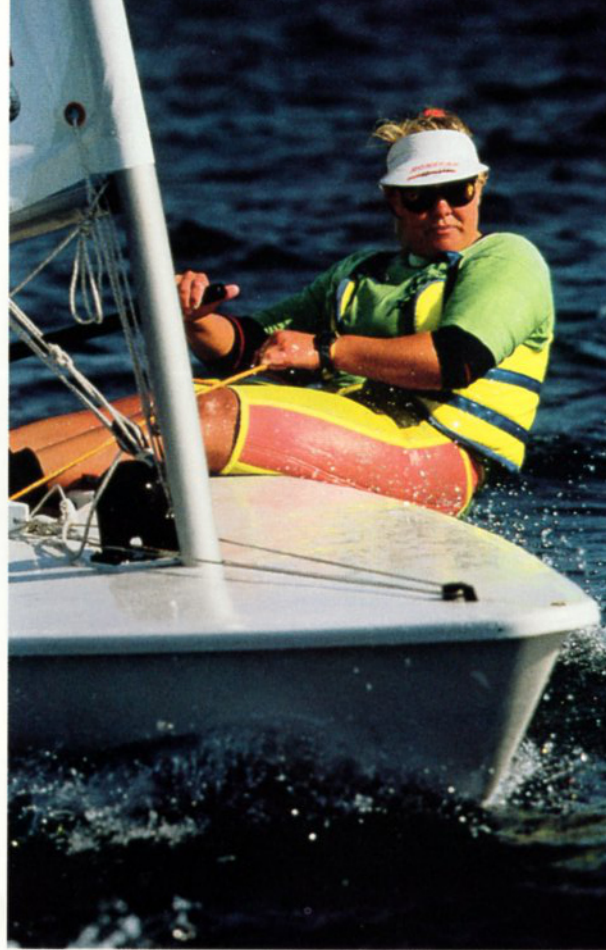
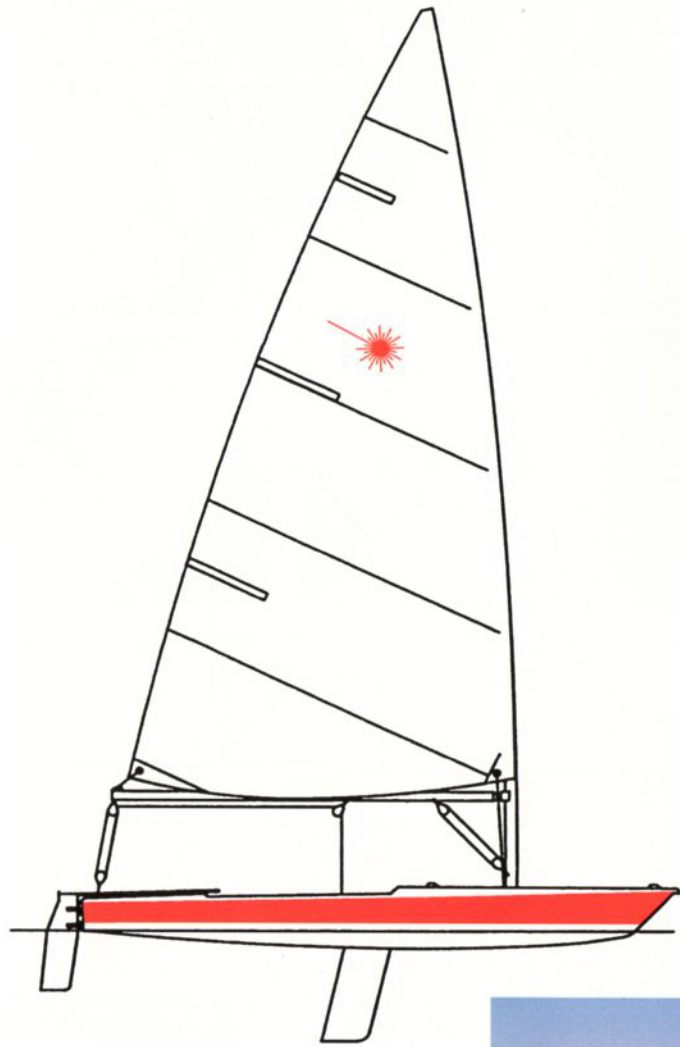

Your path to personal sailing glory begins in a Laser, and you may find, like thousands of others, that the Laser is a lifelong lure.

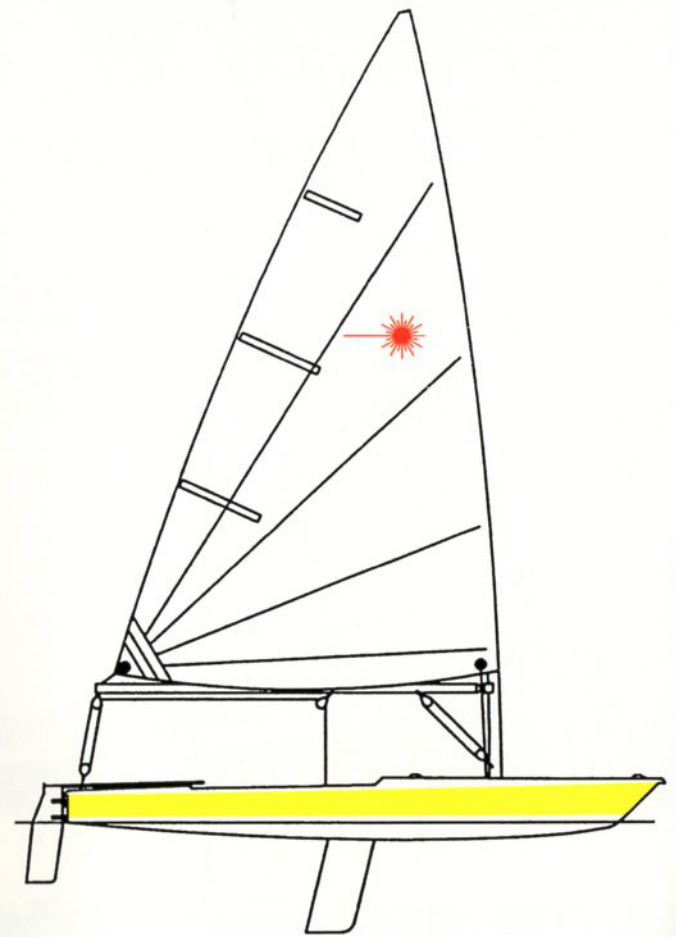


Laser Radial[®]

The Laser Radial is one of the most versatile small boats available. The 62 square foot sail plan is designed for sailors who weigh between 110 and 150 lbs. The Laser Radial is easily managed by smaller adults and upcoming junior sailors. The smaller sailplan opens up the wonderful world of Laser sailing to lighter weight sailors.

The Laser Radial is the choice of the U.S. Sailing Association for the Leiter Trophy, the U.S. Junior Women's Sailing Championship. The Laser Radial is widely used by Yacht Club sailing programs, and is raced in over 60 countries. 80 or more boats typically compete in the Laser Radial World Championship. The Laser Radial is fully approved by the Laser Class Association for participation in over 1000 events in North America each year.

The Laser Radial is the ultimate performance recreational boat. It's exciting, yet easily managed. The reduced sailplan makes the Radial more forgiving and stable. Solid construction guarantees a long virtually maintenance free life.

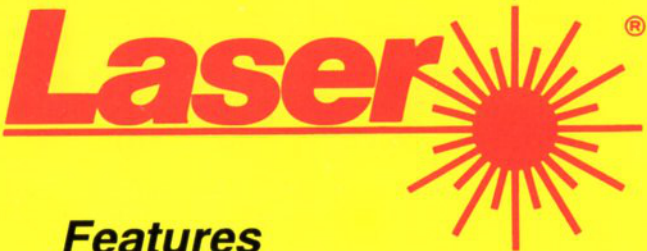
