She is also something of a "sleeper." If you happen to have some other 23'-25' LWL boat it is suggested you not tempt the owner to race with you.

MA PETITE AMIE incorporates considerable technology (performance stuff) into her classic lines. She is also a twin-keel type and is sort of trailerable.

For cruising coastal waters she is particularly well suited. Shoal draft allows her to get into those places you normally only look at through binoculars and her twin keels provide her with the ability to take the ground (upright) almost anywhere.

Ocean crossings are right in line with her capabilities as well and, properly outfitted, she will make an excellent offshore cruiser.

MA PETITE AMIE is the style of boat that will turn heads in any harbor. She will also produce loud grumblings among the crowd of gaff-rig scoffers as they attempt to eat much of what they have said.
