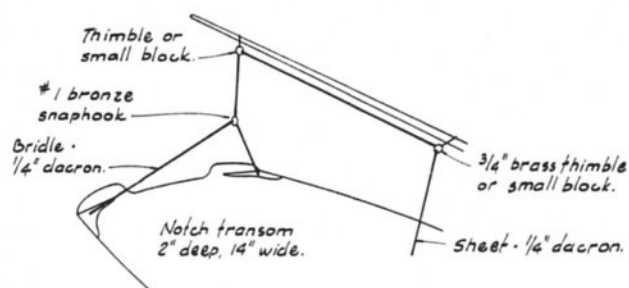


A Sailing Rig for Martha's Tender

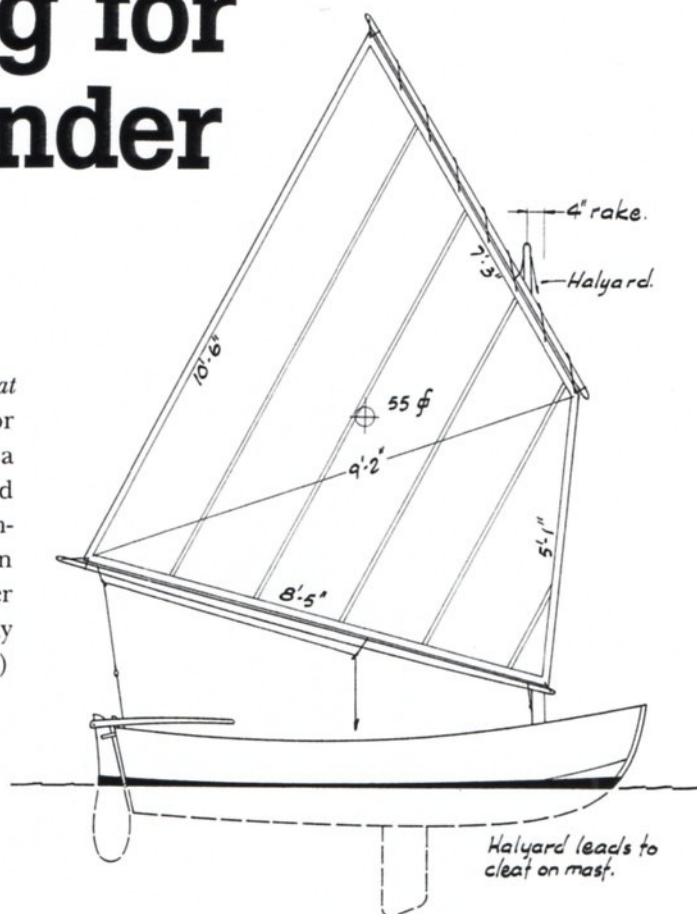

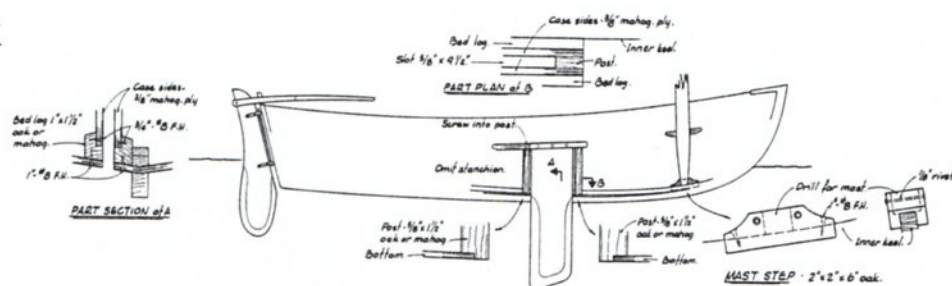

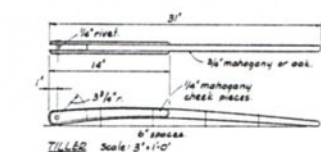
DETAIL of TRANSOM & SHEET



SAIL PLAN



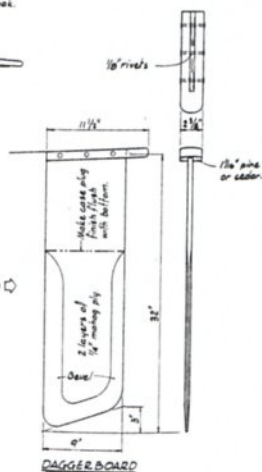
CONSTRUCTION PROFILE



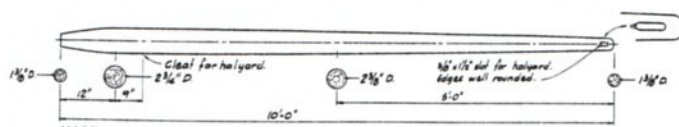
TILLER Scale: 3"=1'-0"



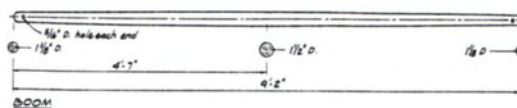
RUDDER Scale: 3"=1'-0"



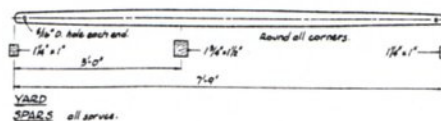
DAGGERBOARD
