Which brings up two amazing features of the Mayflower—a removable storage cooler and a removable storage cooler. Two coolers you can load with lunch, drinks, bait, or (hopefully) your day's catch.

If you happen to be the active type, you can row the Mayflower, simply by unstepping her mast. Oarlocks are included.

What makes the Mayflower tough, also makes her virtually maintenance free—Corlite. So you can spend your time using the Mayflower instead of caring for her.

Of course you'll care for her in a different way...you'll love her.



She's a going boat, the Wildflower. When she's under way, mainsail trimmed, jib set, you can really feel how exciting sailing is.

Her hull weighs only 90 pounds. You know what that means in sailing? Speeeeet.

And she's got 100 square feet of sail area to catch the wind. More speed.

Her conventional sloop rigging is the kind that people cross oceans with. So when you can handle a Wildflower, you've got the basics of sailing down pat.


