


MONTEGO 19



MANUFACTURER'S COMMENT

The Montego 19, another fine J. "Jopie" Helsen design, is the latest in comfortable cruising boats offering quality workmanship. The boat features an all hand-laid-up fiberglass hull and deck, using micro balloon fillers and woodcore sandwich construction. Along with strength and durability, the Montego 19 offers sleek lines, molded contrasting non-skid color, a translucent forward hatch for additional light and ventilation, a 7'0" cockpit to accommodate four sailors comfortably, and a lazarette hatch for easy storage. Below deck the 4'6" headroom and 7'2" beam provides a spacious cabin with berths for four, cushioned by fabric-covered 3" foam. The forward V-berth houses a head compartment with ample storage space on either side. The Montego 19 features a 125% Genoa and slugs and reefing points in the main sail, anodized aluminum mast and boom, S.S. rigging, chrome open-bodied turnbuckles . . . all part of the quality designed into this boat.

The Montego 19 comes complete with main and 125% Genoa, bow pulpit, teak hand rails, cushions, and a long list of standard equipment.
