

WEEKENDER **MONTEGO 19**



The Boat

All hand laid-up fiberglass and excellent molding is the first observation of the Montego 19. This, combined with a large sail area (125% genoa is standard equipment), low wetted surface and light displacement, makes the Montego 19 a quality performance weekender.


The anodized aluminum mast and boom, stainless steel rigging, chrome open bodied turnbuckles, stainless steel wire halyards with spliced dacron tails are the extra details standard on this design.

The deck has a molded two-tone colored non-skid, a fiberglass forward hatch for extra ventilation, large companionway sliding hatch, a cockpit almost 7' long seats four sailors comfortably and has a lazarette hatch with excess to an abundance of storage space under.

A beam of 7' 2" and draft under 14" keel-up, gives the boat easy trailerability and launching characteristics. For sailing performance, a 450 lbs. swing keel with a draft of 4' 6" was designed with an airfoil shape to give the boat life for windward performance and excel off the wind. The airfoil shape in the fiberglass kick-up rudder balances out the excellent helm of the Montego 19.

Below deck, the 4' 6" headroom gives ample room for the berths for four, cushioned by deep fabric-covered foam, a head compartment under the forward berth with a curtain is sufficient for privacy. There is also storage space on either side of the head compartment.

For a performance weekender that's easily trailered and sailed, the Montego 19 is for you...you will be pleasantly surprised.
