The MONTGOMERY 10 was inspired by the need for a utility dinghy with outstanding sailing characteristics. In the past, craft of this type have been notorious for being insufficiently developed as sailboats to be really challenging.

The MONTGOMERY 10 has proven to be very fast and responsive. Her refined gunter rig is efficient, strong, and easily transported. Her speed and sea-keeping abilities are outstanding. In the 1970 America's Teacup Trials conducted by ONE-DESIGN & OFF-SHORE YACHTSMAN Magazine the MONTGOMERY 10 won first place in five of seven events and easily won the trophy for outstanding boat in her division. The MONTGOMERY 10 was the only boat in the trials to be given a perfect score in quality by the judging panel (there were 49 entries).
